2012-2013 HOLMAN MIDDLE SCHOOL CHEERLEADING TRY-OUT INFORMATION PACKET AND GUIDELINES

We will be holding an informational meeting for those interested in trying out for the 2012-2013 Holman Cheerleading Squad in the Holman M.S. auditorium on Thursday, May 3rd from 5:00-5:30.

Tryout practices are scheduled from Monday, June 4th through Wednesday, June 6th in the Holman gym. The practices will begin at 3:30 and all candidates must be picked up by 5:30. During this time, candidates will learn and practice two cheers and one chant as well as jumps.

Actual tryouts will be held Thursday, June 7th beginning at 3:30. Candidates will meet in the gymnasium and will tryout in the order of their numbers (which will be given at the practice). The candidates will tryout in front of a panel of 4-7 judges, including school coaches, and will demonstrate the two cheers and chant in addition to jumps. Judges will score each candidate in the following categories: accuracy/ sharpness of moves, knowledge of material, voice projection, spirit, and jump. We ask that the girls do not leave after they finish their tryout, as we will have the opportunity for call-backs. Team selections will be posted on the following website, https://sites.google.com/site/holmansports/ at 8:00 PM. If you will not have access to the internet Thursday, June 7th please contact the cheerleading coaches for an alternate arrangement.

Each candidate should dress in comfortable shorts, t-shirts, tennis shoes, and no jewelry for practice days. On try-out day, each candidate is to wear a plain white T-shirt, black or blue shorts, tennis shoes, and no jewelry. The candidate's hair is to be secured in a ponytail everyday of practice and tryouts. The length of the shorts must adhere as best as possible to the guidelines of the Code of Conduct and should not have any writing on the seat. Spandex material shorts are prohibited. Practices & tryouts are closed to only the judges, officials, & cheerleading candidates.

ANY STUDENT WHO IS SELECTED FOR THE TEAM WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A PHYSICAL ON FILE DATED AFTER MAY 1, 2012. THOSE WHO ATTEND THE PHYSICAL NIGHT WILL NOT NEED TO OBTAIN A NEW PHYSICAL OVER THE SUMMER IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRACTICE BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER.

Financial Responsibilities for Holman Middle School Cheerleaders

Attire (The following items will need to be purchased):

- Crop Top/ Body Suit
- Lollies (navy blue)
- Cheerleading Shoes
- White Socks
- T-shirts and other spirit wear may be available and are optional.

Uniform:

The cheerleading uniform is the property of Holman Middle School. The uniform must be kept clean and free from stain. NO "colored" drinks may be consumed while wearing the uniform. If it is necessary to alter the provided uniform in any way to fit the child, you must first contact the coach to discuss the options. If it is agreed upon that altering is the best option, the material may not be cut, and the new <u>stitching must be able to be removed</u>. **The length of the uniform may NOT be altered.**

Uniforms will be turned back in to the coaches at the end of the season. Staining, not returning, or destroying uniforms will result in a charge to replace the uniform.

Please note that the uniform includes the following items: cheering skirt, cheering top, warm-up jacket, warm-up pants, and poms.
