

Shoot for the Heart One Patient's Lasting Gift

In 1999, just one month after Keith Wilson was transferred to Nashville for work, he became a patient at Saint Thomas Hospital and learned that he would need open heart surgery. After a successful surgery and intensive rehabilitation, Keith returned to work and normal daily activities.

Having to undergo major cardiac surgery is an extremely difficult experience, but for Keith, it was also a defining one.
