Competition and Repertoire

Concert Tour Prize for Winners in Latin America 2013-2015

The Competition consists of four rounds.

ROUND ONE:

Send a complete application. This should include an unedited DVD or an electronic file (mp4, mov, wmv, etc.)
containing a 'live' performance with a minimum length of 45 minutes which should include at least 30 minutes of twopiano music and up to 15 minutes of piano duet. Repertoire of your choice and may include separate movements from
individual works.

ROUND TWO:

• Live auditions will be held in Beijing, China on December 1st, Hannover, Germany on December 7th, and Chicago, Illinois on December 15th. The performance must be a maximum length of 45 minutes which should include at least 30 minutes of two-piano music and up to 15 minutes of piano duet. Repertoire of your choice and may include separate movements from individual works. The repertoire for the live auditions may not repeat any works from your program in round 1.



ROUND THREE (Semifinals):

- Repertoire from the DVD screening and the live audition rounds may be duplicated for Semifinal recital program. Separate movements from individual works are not allowed.
- Recital one: 45 minutes of two piano music. Program must include Feruccio Busoni Duettino Concertante after Mozart, Shelly Berg - Martha and Mary Meditation (score will be provided). Approximately 9 minutes.
- Recital two: 45 minutes of piano duet music. Program must include Franz Schubert Allegro in A minor, D. 947 "Lebenssturme."
- Recital three: 60 minutes of two piano music. Program must include Jerome Moross "The Last Judgement" (approximately 20 minutes) and new commission for the 12th Dranoff International Two Piano Competition by Gabriela Lena Frank (approximately 12 minutes). Scores for both of these pieces will be provided.

ROUND FOUR (Finals):

- Francis Poulenc Concerto for Two Piano and Orchestra in D. minor, FP 61
- Victor Babin Concerto No. 2
 - * Competitors must prepare both concerti

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- -Applications must be received by the Dranoff Foundation by September 25th, 2012.
- -Applicants should retain copies of all competition materials.
- -Incomplete Applications will not be accepted.
- -Competitors who do not comply with all competition rules will be disqualified.

REPERTORY	AND	PERFOR	MANCES

-All two piano music must be performed by memory with the exception of Shelly Berg – "Martha and Mary Meditation", the 12th Dranoff Competition Commission by Gabriela Lena Frank, and Jerome Moross – "The Last Judgement."

Each team may select the repertory for all three recitals except for the compulsory works stated.

-It is RECOMMENDED to select at least one representative work from the Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Post-Romantic, Impressionist and 20th-Century repertoire.

COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- -The Competition will be adjudicated in English. If candidates are not proficient in English, they must provide a translator for the entire Competition.
- -Returning applicants may only apply twice in the Semi Finals.
- -All Competition rounds are open to the public.
- -All Semifinalists will be scheduled for rehearsal time on the performance stage.
- -All Finalists will be scheduled rehearsal time with the orchestra.

TRAVEL PROCEDURES/HOUSING AND HOSPITALITY IN MIAMI

- -All candidates must provide their own transportation to and from Miami, Florida.
- -All candidates must arrive in Miami by May 9th, 2013.
- -Each competitor is responsible for his/her ENTRY VISA to the United States. Visas are obtainable at the United States Embassies in each individual country.
- -All competitors will be housed in individual homes by residents of Miami. Meals, transportation and practice facilities will be provided May 9th May 16th, 2013.

WINNERS INSTRUCTIONS- CONDITIONS AND CONTRACTUAL ARRANGEMENTS

- -The Winner of the newly-commissioned composition for the Competition Prize will perform this selected work in the program of the Finals.
- -The Winner of the Jerome Moross Prize will perform the designated work in the program of the Finals.
- -The winners agree to perform all concerts and programs arranged and contracted by the Dranoff Foundation following the Competition.
- -The Dranoff Foundation reserves the right to advise and consult winners in the selection of repertory for concerts and/or recordings.
- -All prize winners are requested and expected to perform two recitals (without fees) at dates mutually agreed upon by and for the support of the Dranoff Foundation, Inc.

GENERAL RULES

- -I hereby grant the Dranoff Foundation permission to electronically record, film or videotape for (live) broadcast, distribution on CD and DVD, or for future distribution on any media, all or any part of our performances. I waive all claims to money acquired by the Dranoff Foundation (or those acquiring rights or licenses from the Foundation) through the use of such recorded, filmed or videotaped material.
- -Pianists or their personal associates may not contact or speak to any member of the Jury during the competition.
- -Competitors who do not comply with any or all of competition rules will be disqualified.

I hereby declare that I have completed the application form for the 12th International Dranoff Two Piano Competition completely and truthfully. If I'm admitted as a participant in the 12th Dranoff International Two Piano Competition, I agree to abide by all the rules and conditions of the competition as set forth in this official application document. I understand that any decisions by the Dranoff Foundation or the International Jury are final and cannot be appealed. Further, if I win a prize in the Dranoff Competition, I consent to the aforementioned conditions for prizewinners.
