BYERS HOMESTEAD



The Art on the River Festival will be held on the beautiful grounds of Byers Homestead located in Commerce Township, Michigan. The land was settled in 1825 by a German immigrant, Abram Walrod, who built his log cabin next to a canal that is fed by the Huron River. The log cabin was later replaced by the 1840's farmhouse that still stands today. Byers is also known as "the Duck Farm" to local residents. These residents still bring their children to feed the ducks and take a peaceful stroll of the grounds.



EXHIBITION STANDARDS: All work that is exhibited must be of original design and handcrafted by the artisan. <u>No</u> imported items, reproductions, anything that is unsafe, toxic or considered "hawking" will be allowed. Any commercially produced parts used in all works must play a subordinate role and may not be sold separately.

EXHIBITOR RULES: All exhibitors at the Art on the River Festival must remain open during the published hours of the show. Absolutely no tear-downs before 7:00 p.m. Exhibitors must provide covered, professional artist tent or comparable to cover their booth area designated by the festival staff. All booth tents must be properly weighted down (no exceptions). All materials must be contained within your 10'x10' booth space. No debris may be left on the grounds of Byers Farm after breakdown.
