“Getting to Know You” Lesson

Objectives:

The students will comprehend spoken English and use English presentation skills.

Materials:

2 x Handouts (BINGO and Sentence Search)
Stickers

Task	Time	Procedure
Review of Lesson 5	5	<p>ALT and JTE take turns asking the students questions from the last lesson to check for understanding.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Where would you like to go...? 2. Do you have any plans for the weekend? 3. How will you get there? 4. Who will go with you? 5. What will you do there?
<p>BINGO: “Getting to know you”</p>	20	<p>ALT and JTE will pass out the BINGO handout. ALT will read the instructions:</p> <p>Introduce yourself to a fellow classmate, and ask them a question from the BINGO card below. If their answer is “YES,” write that student’s name in that square. You can only use each classmate once and don’t forget to cross out the square with my face.</p> <p>ALT and JTE will read the following dialogue to demonstrate the game:</p> <p>ALT: Hello, my name is Matthew, it’s nice to meet you. JTE: My name is _____, it’s nice to meet you too. ALT: “Do you like eating hamburgers, _____?” JTE: Yes, thank you for asking (or) NO, I’m sorry.”</p> <p>(And then if the answer is YES, the ALT will write the JTE’s name in the square and move on.)</p>
<p>BINGO Presentation: “Tattle Tale”</p>	5	<p>JTE calls on one student. That student must choose a name from their Bingo card and share something about that student from the BINGO game. Then, the student they call on must do</p>

Sentence Search	8	JTE and ALT have students make teams of 4 or 5. JTE will pass out the two handouts (one of each per group) while ALT explains rules. In five minutes, each team races to make as many sentences out of the words as they can. When the time is up, the team with the most correct sentences wins. Also, stickers will be given to the team with the longest sentence.
Sentence Presentation	8	JTE will call on random students and have them present one sentence from their team. Each student that presents gets a sticker.

BINGO example script:

ALT: Hello, my name is Matthew, it's nice to meet you.

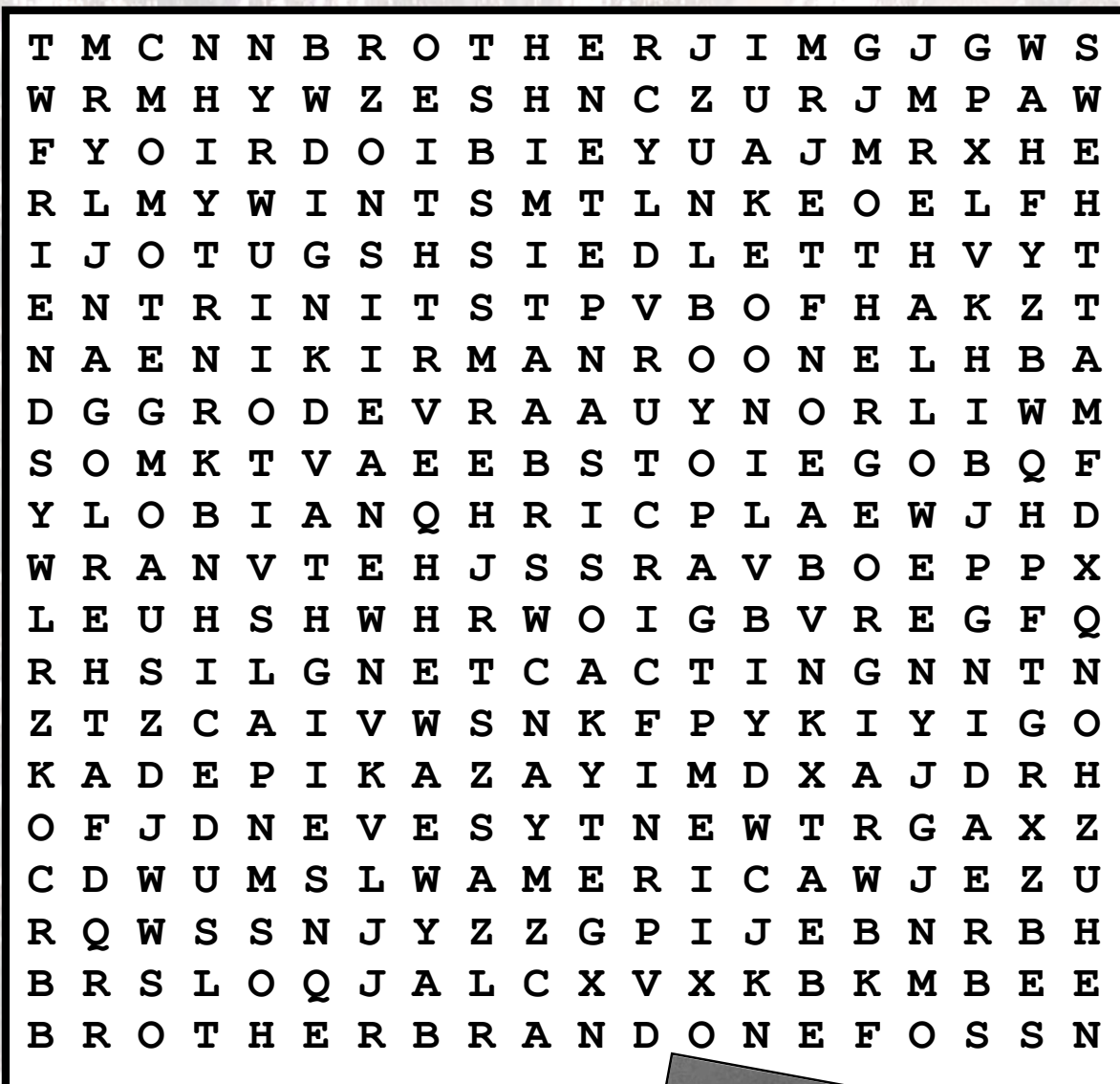
