Introducing Today's Sermon

Ecclesiastes 11: How to Waste Your Life

Faith Lives Where We Do Not Know

When we think of someone who was extremely wise and

experienced in life, we cannot help but think of King Solomon. The Book of Proverbs is a masterfully composed book oozing with common sense written by the thoughtful and introspective King. The Proverbs are generally simple statements that strike to the heart of the most common experiences of the human condition. God's wisdom is exalted. Foolishness is condemned.



As much wisdom as Solomon possesses, he frequently and humbly shares with the reader his own lack of understanding. One thing, among others, that we learn is that there are many things, he and we, do not know or understand. God is in charge and His ways are not always ours, and vice versa.

In chapter eleven Solomon encourages us to faith, to trust in a sovereign God who has all of the answers, while we do not. As finite humans we do not know what evil shall be upon the earth (v 2). We do not know the way of the spirit (v 5). We do not know the works of God who maketh all (v 5). We do not really know what shall prosper (v 6). The declaration of these statements is found in the context of giving. "Cast thy bread. . . Give a portion to seven . . ." (vs 1,2). Knowing human nature, Solomon is dealing with man's tendency to forestall generosity. There's always a reason "not to give" something of oneself. The young are particularly in view.
