I understand that the nature of the activities during the program may include but not be limited to workshops, outdoor and indoor group activities, group accommodation, hiking, sports & challenge games, communal eating, socializing, travelling in motor vehicles and that although due care will be taken to minimise accidents risks may arise during these activities.

I hereby authorise the leader in charge of the camp or the particular activity in which my child / myself is involved to consent, where it is impracticable to communicate with me or my nominated contact person, to my child / myself receiving such medical treatment or surgical treatment as the leader may deem necessary at any time during the camp. I hereby authorise and consent **Christ the King Parish**, its employees, volunteers, agents, officers, and contractors obtaining and administering medical assistance, including first aid, transport, blood transfusion and/or anaesthetic if required and I agree to indemnify **Christ the King Parish** its employees, volunteers, agents, officers, and contractors for any cost or liability arising out of the performance of any medical procedure in relation to such medical assistance.
