We will have open divisions as follows:

Pee Wee- 10 & under

Novice- Anyone in their first year of showing

Junior- Second or more year of showing and not yet 14 as of Jan. 1, 2015

Senior- 14-18 as of January 1, 2015

Open Adult- 19-50 in age

Oldie BUT Goodie- Over 50 division

There will be a \$500 pot divided among the top 4 showmen that make it to the youth division master class. 1st- \$200, 2nd-\$150, 3rd- \$100, 4th- \$50. Master Showman will also receive the Paul Fleming Memorial Award. They will get a plaque and also have their name put on the Master Trophy to be displayed in the Ward O'Hara Agricultural Museum.

<u>Saturday, July 25th at 11am- Breed Classes- Judge- Jamie Black.</u> Starting with calves. We will cycle through breeds in age of animal in alphabetical order (Ayrshires first- Milking Shorthorns last).

OPEN SHOW Animals must be in place by NOON, Friday, July 24! NO TRUCKING IN AFTER THIS TIME! Release Time will be following the show.

Three other BONUSES with OUR SHOW!!!! FREE BREAKFAST EVERYDAY for dairy exhibitors and a PIG ROAST (for FREE) on the evening of Saturday, July 25th. Also, free straw for cattle exhibitors.

A NOTE ON OUR CURRENT FACILITIES...

- -Camper Hook-ups for power-only will be extremely limited. Many local hotels are available or you may sleep in the tent or alongside your animals.
- -Animals WILL BE housed in TENTS! These tents have limited electrical hook-ups so plan accordingly. Bring extension cords and be willing to use designated areas for clipping if need be. The more fitting you do at home, the better.
- -There is NO PARLOR. You must bring your own portable milker. There will be a portable vacuum pump and bucket milker on site. Ask superintendents before discarding any milk.
- -FREE Straw will be PROVIDED for Cattle Exhibitors at **NO COST**, to allow you to bring MORE ANIMALS AND LESS MATERIALS!
- -Tents will be allowed, but must be taken down EACH morning.

Ground Rules:

In order to maintain safety to all fair attendees and exhibitors, The Remember the Big 6 Country and Youth Fair Committee has established the following Ground Rules:

- 1.) Overnight in the Tent Absolutely no one under the age of 18 is allowed to stay/be in the tents without a chaperone after 10PM. Only exhibitors are allowed to stay/be on the grounds. All others must seek approval from the Big 6 committee and file necessary paperwork.
- 2.) Any youth exhibitor wishing to stay overnight with their animals must fill out and submit an Overnight Request Form for Open Show. These forms are due to Ward O'Hara Agricultural Museum with your entries. Please visit our www.rememberthebig6.com website for this form.
- 3.) Tents will close at 10PM and lights out at 11PM.
- 4.) NO ALOCOHOL IS PERMITTED IN THE TENTS AT ANY TIME.
- 5.) Manure is to be placed in or on the side of the dumpster where signs are placed.
- 6.) The tent aisle and wash rack areas are to be kept free of grooming tools, equipment, hair and manure. PLEASE clean up after your animal. Keep outside of the tent clean and free of hay, straw and manure.
- 7.) Exhibitors and their families will act kind and cooperative at all times.

Remember: Animals MUST have proof of rabies vaccination at least 14 days prior, as well as shipping fever vaccination and Negative BVD. A private vet will be examining!

Class 18- Best three females

Class 19- Dairy herd (4 animals- 2 must have calved at least once)

Premiums are as follows: 1st-\$20, 2nd-\$15, 3rd-\$10 and 4th-\$5; and will be paid out following the show. Junior Champion of each breed will be awarded \$100. Overall Grand Champion of each breed will be awarded \$300.00. Supreme Champion of the show will be awarded \$1000. These will be paid out at the show. Please see cattle superintendent.
