Notification that the work samples are available on Sentral will be sent by email and via the School Stream App (instructions for download included in this newsletter).

The work that is now uploaded to Sentral will be in a consistent format and will contain the following:

- Name and date of assessment in the header.
- Brief description of the purpose of the work.
- Sample of work.
- The achievement standard that the student has reached (highlighted in pink).
- The next achievement standard that the student is working towards (highlighted in yellow).
- The footer contains the page number and number of pages in the sample (i.e 1/2)

3. Under Edit/Alerts select My Schools and select your School to open the Notifications page

5. When you have finished, use the Back button to return to the Settings page, then select Done to return to your School
