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INDEPENDENT RESEARCH PROJECT INTRODUCTION


Scenario:

You will also discuss the social issue(s) that your association is involved with, that is related to exercise, physical education, sport, and/or physical movement.

The Kinesiology Sport and Health Fair will be held on ______ in Gym C, at which you will be required to present you findings to invited quests and other students. This will include a presentation board, pamphlet and interactive component. You will be acting as the Association's spokesperson for the day.

Issues:	Social Problems: shut-in seniors Inequity: equal access Government: anti-animal policies (parks, apartments, etc.)
PSE Links:	Anatomy, digestion, food groups, vitamins, exercise routines.

1. PART #1 - Preliminary Report: (10 marks)

a. Form #1: Preliminary Report

- i) Name of your association
- ii) State and summarize the Mission Statement of the organization.
- iii) Identify and briefly describe the social issues they are bring awareness to? (NOTE: think in terms of the four categories). (2)
- iv) List specific programs that they offer. (2)
- v) Describe your association's link to this course. Use your course outline and text as a reference for those areas we have not yet covered. (2)
- vi) On the back list a minimum of 6 resources, recorded properly in MLA Style. Group them according to research on the Association, Social Issues and PSE Related Topics.

2. PART #2 - Resource Interview: (15 marks)

- a. Form #2A: Resource Interview Rubric
 - i) Hand in a documented review of the discussion with your contact (i.e. a spokesperson from your chosen association). There should be a minimum of 10 questions that you have asked them to ascertain relevant association information and issue awareness. Follow-up questions and/or notes to your originally prepared questions should also be included.
 - ii) Please include the rough notes as well as a typed version.
- b. Form #2B: Interview Verification Letter
 - i) This form needs to be signed by both you and your resource person to verify that they understand, and have agreed to anticipate.

3. PART #3 - Secondary Report - Teacher Interview: (15 marks) Due Date:_____

- a. Form #3: Teacher Interview Rubric:
 - i) Create a rough, but detailed sketch, and description of a display board, interactive component, and pamphlet/brochure that you will use in presenting your material.
 - Present a minimum of 10 resources, recorded properly in MLA format (*including* 1 *human,* 1 *web site and* 1 *journal entry*). These need to be about the Association, the Social Issues and the PSE Connections.
 - iii) There will be a 10 minute interview with your teacher to discuss your work to date; be prepared to defend and to be asked questions about your research.

- a. Form #4: Final Product Marking Scheme
- b. Display Board
 - i) Typically a three panel display: Left-ISSUES, Centre-ASSOC, Right-PSE4U
 - ii) It must be visually appealing and informative, as you want to 'grab' the attention of potential readers and then educate them.
 - iii) Include association web-site, address, phone number, and any other relevant contact information, **but do not plagiarize you resources**
 - iv) Use titles/subtitles and colour and be sure that it is neat and organized.
- c. Interactive Component
 - i) The objective is to attract the participant to your poster and educate them about some facet of association and/or its issues. It should be a dynamic and informative, people oriented 'instrument'.
 - ii) This interactive component is **NOT** to be part of your display board. Use of multimedia is encouraged
 - iii) Ask yourself the following questions: Is it creative? Does it motivate and educate us? Does it involve a degree of audience interaction?
- d. Pamphlet/Brochure
 - i) Create a visually appealing and informative pamphlet or brochure that outlines the importance of your chosen association and the three main areas of information: the association, the issues, and course links.
 - ii) This pamphlet/brochure is to be a supplement to your display board, but **NOT** a part of it
 - iii) Give credit when it is owed (i.e. re: information)
- e. Reference List
 - i) Minimum of **15 resources**: recorded in proper format, a variety in types (ex. No more than half are websites), and covering the links to PSE 4U, and related social issue
 - ii) Must be available at the Health Fair

Remember that not all questions are about getting information for the display board, but to have a fuller understanding of their mission statement and purpose. You should ask a **minimum of 10 questions**, but the more you ask, the better your results. Also, as you conduct the interview other follow up questions will arise which you should also include.

Question Ideas:

- The Association
 - The Mission Statement
 - History of the organization
 - Particulars of the infrastructure, address, staff etc.
 - Programs offered
 - Future plans

- The Social Issues:
 - Politics and Government, Media, Deviation, Inequity
- The PSE connections:
 - (this will vary between topics)
- Statistics
- Resources:
 - people, books, pamphlets, videos, websites.
