Stop Complaining!



omplaining comes easy to us. Our Great, Great, etc., grandfather, Adam, invented it. When asked by God if he ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, he immediately complained to God that it was because of the woman that God gave him! In a way, we can appreciate Adam's outburst; he was about to have

the entire nature of life as he knew it cursed from the perfect setting in which he and his wife were placed. Today, we have fine tuned complaining to the most mundane things like when our coffee is given to us a bit hotter than the normal 187° F or a quarterback throws an incomplete pass. Adam would be shocked to see what he passed down to his descendants.

Complaining is nothing more than the outward reaction of one's rejection towards God's providence. Some wanted the weather to be sunny and God chose otherwise. Someone wanted to get that job, but God had other plans. There may be a tendency to think that it is not a lack of faith in God's ability to control everything, but rather His misguided perspective to not consider their perceived concerns while establishing His eternal plan. When one questions God's providence, one also questions His holiness, sovereignty, and goodness.

Do people complain because they see God as evil rather than good? When the Jews were in the wilderness, they complained to God (through Moses) claiming that He brought them out to the desert to die. There was no food, no water, and no meat. Remember, a magician's trick is most effective when he demonstrates that "there is nothing up his sleeve." God doesn't do tricks, but regardless of what or where people find themselves, God promises to never fail or forsake us. This is accepting God's providence.

If you need a strategy to overcome complaining, do the biblical alternative; learn to be thankful in all things. Just as we learn to complain about the most mundane things, 1 Cor. 10:31 teaches us to give God glory in those situations. The difference between the saved and unsaved is not so much the blessings God provides or the easiness of life's ways, but the appreciation that God is at work in their lives and thus, we (should) have nothing about which to complain.

The more we practice being thankful, the less we will practice complaining.

August 19, 2014- Primary Election Day – Polls open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

August 19, 2014- Deadline for absentee by-mail ballots to be postmarked.



THE LAW OF RECIPROCITY

Theme

When we give we shall receive. The standard of measurement we use in our giving is the same standard of measurement God uses in the return on our giving.

Scripture Reading

Luke 6:37-38 "Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven: Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again."

Relating to the Scripture

In this passage of Scripture, Jesus gives us four laws which are part of the laws of reciprocity. That is, laws which are reciprocated. These are actions where there is an exchange of privileges which are determined by the initiator.

The first law says if we do not judge others, we will not be judged. Second, if we do not condemn others, we will not be condemned. Third, if we forgive others, we will be forgiven. Fourth, if we give, it shall be given unto

This fourth law is made a little clearer in the New American Standard Bible.

Luke 6:37: "Give, and it will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, they will pour into your lap. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

Let's look at two of the principles of this law.

- 1) When we give, we shall receive. The Apostle Paul stated it this way: "...whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." Galatians 6:7
- 2) The same measurement we use in giving is used to determine our return. Again Paul wrote: "...He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully." 2 Corinthians 9:6

So, from Jesus' words, we see that when we give, we shall receive again; pressed down, shaken together, and running over even into our laps. We also see that whatever standard of measurement we use in our giving, God will use the same standard of measurement to return our giving back unto us. Just imagine, by the force of this law, God is allowing us to determine the amount of our return from our giving. Truly what a privilege and honor it is to give.

Offering Admonition / Confession

The laws of God do not fail. When we give, we shall receive again. According to the measure of our giving, God gives back unto us. In this way, God is allowing us to determine the amount of our return. What a privilege to give!



Learn to be a Giver

Luke 6:38 "For if you give, you will get! Your gift will return to you in full and overflowing measure,
pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, and running over. Whatever measure you use to give - large or small - will be used to measure what is given back to you." (TLB)
