Tournament Rules

Entry Requirements...

This tournament will observe the rules of participation & play established by the Texas High School Bowling Club with correlation to USBC rules & regulations. A dress code will be strictly enforced, **NO**JEANS. Participation is by <u>invitation only</u> and an invitation to participate is offered to THSBC school-sponsored club teams that meet <u>At Least One</u> of the following entry requirements:

- 1. Participated in the 2010-2011 THSBC State Championship Tournament
- 2. Placed in the Top 5 of your Designated THSBC Regional Tournament
- 3. Placed 1st in your designated THSBC District
- 4. 2010 Kat Cup Participant

If a team eligible to participate elects not to accept an invitation, the invitation to participate will be offered to the next school team(s) based on order of finish in any of the entry requirements noted above.

Please NOTE: It is the responsibility of the school coach to determine the team eligibility however Tournament Officials will check State & Regional results to verify.

Due to facility considerations, the maximum number of participating Teams is limited to Thirty-Four (34) and will be determined on a "first come-first served" PAID ENTRY...based on postmark date & keeping in consideration # of boys teams vs. girls teams (18/16) or tbd.

Reservations to participate WILL NOT be accepted by telephone or e-mail.

It is HIGHLY ANTICIPATED that this tournament will be a "SELL-OUT" so please send entry's at your soonest convenience...and or NO LATER THEN October 31st, 2011.

Tournament Format

There are two (2) separate team divisions: Boys & Girls. Five (5) participating bowlers per team. Team roster is unlimited. The format is the same for each division...

Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl three (3) regular games on the same pair, pre-assigned lanes. Based on the total (3 games) from the qualifying round, the field will be cut to the top eight (8) teams in each division and will advance to the championship baker match play round. All ties for advancing team positions will be broken by a 10 th frame roll off by ONE selected individual from each team due to time.

<u>Championship Round</u>: The eight (8) teams in each division will be seeded based on total team scores from qualifying in a single elimination, best of three (3) Baker game match play format.

Championship Round Match 1: A. #1 vs. #8, B. #4 vs. #5, C. #3 vs. #6, D. #2 vs. #7

Championship Round Match 2: Winner of Al. A vs. B & Winner of Bl. C vs. D

Championship Round Match 3: Winner of A1. vs. Winner of B1.

Team Standings: The final Team Standings in this tournament will be determined as follows and will be available on the website:

1st Place: Winner of Championship Round & The Kat Cup

2nd Place: Loser of Championship Round

3rd & 4th Place: The highest seeded losing team in Championship round Match (2) A1 will be awarded 3rd and the highest seeded losing team in B1 will be 4th.

5th-8th Place: Will be determined by the four losing teams in the Championship Round Match 1 and will be awarded based on highest seed=5th to lowest seed=8th.

9th Place-???: Will be determined based from Highest Pin Total to Lowest, the three (3) game total team score from the Qualifying Round.

PLEASE NOTE: The scores from the Qualifying Round will **ONLY** be used to:

A. Determine the teams that advance to the Championship Round

B. Seed the Position of the Eight (8) teams in the Championship Round

C. To select the Boys & Girls Six (6) Member-All-Tournament Team
