Missing the Best

ohnny Hutchinson had an opportunity to be a drummer in an up and coming band. His friend Pete was recently dismissed because the band's manager

felt he just wasn't a strong enough drummer to lead the group to the level they were heading. Johnny was a good friend of Pete's and felt badly taking the gig from him. After playing with the band for a few concerts, he chose to leave... and was replaced by a lesser talented, Ringo Starr.

We have all made decisions we probably wish we hadn't made. Life is composed of a continual path of intersecting choices that seem almost as involuntary as a marble in a pachinko machine. None-the-less, God has given us intelligence, reason, and direction to adequately make right decisions, but too often we fail.

Numbers, Chapter 20, tells the stories of three individuals whose lives reflected faith in God. vet because of their poor decisions, failed to finish the trek into the Promise Land.

Miriam. Moses' sister, who led the Israelites in celebration across the Red Sea, challenged Moses' anointment before God. In Numbers, Chapter 12. she was given leprosy. She died in the Wilderness of Zin (v.1).

At the end of the chapter, Aaron was told by God to go to the top of Mount Hor. He conspired with Moses to condemn the Israelites at the Rock of Meribah. On Hor, Moses instructs him to remove his priestly garments and place them on his son Eleazar. There Aaron died (v.28).

The third was Moses. For 40 years, Moses had been a faithful servant. At Meribah, he was frustrated at the moans of his people. He did not speak to the rock but struck it twice with his rod - in disobedience to God's command (v.11-12). For his disobedience, Moses would not step foot into Israel. In Deuteronomy, Chapter 34, on Mount Nebo. Moses could only see the land he was forbidden to enter.

The deficiencies of our flesh can so easily betray us from the best God has in store for us. Johnny Hutchinson decided, unwittingly, never to be a part of the Beatles. Our decisions will be a far greater tragedy if we never go on achieving the goals God has set before us. Walking with God is not involuntary: it is a continual series of decisions to walk in faith and obedience for His purpose.

PROVIDING FOR OUR OWN HOUSE

Theme

Christians provide for their family members who are in need. Christians also provide for their spiritual family.

Scripture Reading

(Starts at 9:45 a.m.)

1 Timothy 5:3-8 "Honour widows that are widows indeed. But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God. Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day. But she that liveth in pleasure is dead while she liveth. And these things give in charge, that they may be blameless. But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel."

Relating to the Scripture

In this passage, Paul is concerned about the place and care of widows in the church. In the ancient world...widows were often among the most weak and vulnerable members of society. Paul's instruction is that the primary responsibility for the care of widows rests on members of the immediate family (children or grandchildren). Only when that assistance is not available, when the widow is "left all alone," does the church become responsible.

The phrase "to be worse than an unbeliever": implies that even unbelievers are expected to care for those of their own households. Believers who neglect this responsibility are thus acting "worse than" unbelievers. And such a life in the world represents a denial of faith.

We are responsible for the care of our family. We are especially responsible for the care of our own household. This principle of responsible Christian love also has application for our church.

In our world, there are many good ministries to support such as: Red Cross, the Salvation Army, Scouting and TV ministries. They should come only after we have taken care of our own house, our church. How sad indeed it would be for we who are blessed each and every week by our church, to support others, but fail to support our very own church family.

It is not the world, but we who are part of this church family who have the responsibility to provide for its upkeep and the continuation of its many ministries.
