



Camp Information

The 3rd Epsom Scout Group are organising a Family Camp for all Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers associated with the Group and also their parents, brothers and sisters.

We are going to Boidierhurst Scout Campsite, signposted off Box Hill Road, Headley (satnav postcode KT20 7PL) so it is not very far and it will be possible to camp from Friday 18th September 2012 6pm until Sunday afternoon 20th September.

The Camp/Holiday Leader will be Richard Ascough. With the Assistance of Judith Sitford, Peter Sitford, Wayne Smith and other adults.

Activities are currently being arranged but are likely to include trails, fire building, cooking, challenges and games. All activities will be run in accordance with the Scout Association's Safety Rules.

We would ideally like to get every family at the site on the Saturday, so even if you do not fancy camping, please join us at 9.30am to enjoy fun activities rounded off with a camp fire at 7pm. The site is close enough to go home afterwards. If you need to borrow a tent then we can source one for you. Note that the nights do count towards the children's night away badges.

The aim on the Saturday is to put people into teams and undertake a number of exciting challenges. In the afternoon we hold our team gun carriage race (it is great fun for all the family). We close the day with a Group Campfire.

The cost of the camp will be as follows:

Friday night – no charge (note we will not be providing meals on Friday night)

Saturday – Adults £10, Children £10

Includes breakfast, lunch and supper

Sunday - £4 per person

Includes breakfast and lunch

(a maximum of £50 per family for the weekend)

The fees are set to just cover costs and food. We would however appreciate it if you could bring a cake.

It should be noted that we never prevent children joining in activities for reasons of money. If you have any problems with the payment, please speak in confidence to a leader.

Specific Camping Rules:

- All Children are able to camp without parents on both Friday and Saturday, however we would really like the whole family to come and enjoy the experience. We do need to know in advance who is camping so we ensure there are enough adults present.
- Depending on numbers (and also family preferences) we expect to sleep children in their appropriate section (Beavers, Cubs, etc....), however they can also sleep with their parents if this is your preference.
- Siblings (younger and older) are welcome to come but will be expected to sleep with their parents (or in their own tents)

- All Adults staying overnight need to be DBS checked if this has not already occurred (or at least started the process). This is fairly simple and initially just requires your permission, date of birth, email address and full name. Once registered on the system Rama will need to validate your ID
