

## **ALASKA STATE ELKS CAMP RULES**

**All persons attending the Alaska State Elks Camp are required to read and adhere to the following rules:**

1. The following are strictly prohibited: profanity in any form, pornography, fighting, possession of weapons or knives of any kind, possession or use of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.
2. All campers are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner that will not disturb other campers or leaders. Noise in the cabin area should be controlled.
3. All persons on the lake must wear camp supplied approved PFD's.
4. No child is allowed on or in the lake without leader supervision and permission.
5. No child is allowed in the pool without leader supervision and permission.
6. Campers must have counselor or other leader supervision at all times.
7. All fires must be approved by the Camp Directors and must be confined to the pavilion grill or barbecue pit.
8. Cutting of live trees on camp property is prohibited.
9. The picnic area must be cleaned after each use.
10. All cabins must be kept neat and clean. Beds must be made and personal gear stored neatly when not in use.
11. There will be no running or other rough or dangerous play in the shower houses.
12. Bows and arrows will be used only in designated areas with counselor or other adult supervision.
13. Vandalism is not allowed and will not be tolerated anywhere at the camp.
14. No littering: put your garbage in a trash receptacle.
15. **No stealing. Stay away from other peoples belongings,**
16. The following areas are off limits to campers: caretaker's apartment, storeroom below caretaker's apartment, the shop building, the laundry room, and the camp office.
17. Participation in activities, including the hike and cabin chores, is mandatory.
18. Electronic devices are strongly discouraged. There are lots of activities each day to keep the campers busy. They are also a potential theft problem and the camp will not be responsible for damage or theft to these items.
19. Telephone contact will be made on an "as needed" basis or in case of an emergency. Cell phones are becoming a serious distraction to camp activities. If you must send a cell phone with your child, it is strongly recommended it be turned in to the Camp Directors during camp. Abuse of cell phones will result in Camp Directors confiscating them and holding them until the end of camp. Please do not plan to have your child check in with you each day!
20. **Above all, HAVE FUN!**
