GUIDELINES FOR COURSE SELECTION YEAR 12, 2016

1. REFLECT ON YOUR RESULTS AND CONSIDER YOUR FUTURE

Before you select your courses for Year 12, review your Semester 1 results. You must be confident that you are achieving to the appropriate standard to make it worthwhile for you to continue with the same courses in Year 12. Review your career and further study plans to make sure that you have the appropriate course of study to reach these goals.

2. SEEK ADVICE

If at any stage in the process of selecting courses for Year 12, 2016 you are unsure of what to do then seek advice. Talk with your parents, teachers and Head of Senior School, Ms Stringer. These people are all willing to spend the time to help you make the right choice for Year 12.

3. FIVE OR SIX COURSES IN YEAR 12?

In Year 12 you have the option of studying five rather than six courses. Your additional time is scheduled as Private Study classes that you must attend. In making the decision to reduce to five courses you must be sure that:

- Your chances of achieving your WACE are not affected.
- The course that you drop is not a pre-requisite or preferred course for tertiary studies at the end
 of Year 12.
- Your potential Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) will not be affected by your decision.

4. CHANGING COURSES FOR YEAR 12

Selecting new courses for Year 12 may be possible, but must be considered very carefully. If you plan to choose a new course for Year 12 then, the Subject Coordinator concerned or relevant teacher must approve this in writing by signing the selection form. Many Year 12 courses require the background knowledge and skills from Year 11 and starting them in Year 12 is not always possible. Selection of new courses is also restricted by their position on the timetable grid and class sizes.

Courses on Offer Year 12 2016 WACE BREADTH OF STUDY LIST – 2016

To achieve a grade at the end of Year 12 and to be eligible for WACE, students must complete three paired units in the same course, eg, ATAR English Units 3 and 4. They must also make a genuine attempt in the WACE External Examination(s) if applicable.

There are two pathways that can be followed in Year 12.

ATAR PATHWAY

This is designed for students who are interested in gaining an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) for the purpose of entry into University. It is strongly recommended that students who are capable should choose Year 12 ATAR Unit 3 and 4 courses (including English and Mathematics).

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAY

This is designed for students who may not wish to gain an ATAR but may be interested in applying for an STP Course (formerly TAFE) or one of the alternative entry pathways to University. Students on this pathway may choose a combination of ATAR and General Unit 3 and 4 courses and must complete a Vocational Education and Training (VET) Certificate qualification, depending on their final study destination.
