



Instrument Hire Agreement 2016 Band / String Programme

Peter Carnley Anglican Community School offers students the opportunity to hire a musical instrument. The purpose of a hired instrument is to allow students, parents and tutors to ascertain the suitability of the student to the instrument as well as an opportunity for the student to test their enjoyment of learning that particular instrument.

The cost of hiring an instrument per term is usually:

- Violin \$40
- Cello, saxophone, flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone \$75

However, for all Band and String Programme students the cost has been covered by the School.

Your child will receive their instrument on their first lesson. Upon issue of the instrument, the following conditions will apply:

- It is the student's responsibility to keep the instrument secure at all times – at home, at School and while in transit.
- Students are not permitted under any circumstances to loan their instrument to other students or make exchanges.
- Printed music books and other bulky materials are not to be placed inside the instrument case.
- The cost of repair to an instrument will be the student's responsibility if the damage was a direct result of student neglect. Where repair is not viable the instrument will need to be replaced at the cost of the family.
- Many instruments come with accessories. It is the student's responsibility to ensure the security of these accessories as well as the instrument itself.
- It is the student's responsibility to regularly clean their instrument as instructed by the tutor.
- All instrument cases are to be clearly labelled with the child's name and year group.
- The instrument is to be retuned in good order to the Music Department and handed directly to a music staff member. The staff member will issue you with a receipt for the return of the instrument as confirmation that it has been received.
- If the instrument is lost or stolen whilst on loan, the instrument will be replaced at the cost of the family of the student.

It is advised that parents check their home and content insurance policy as the School will accept no responsibility for damaged or lost instruments. The School will organise any general serving of the instrument required.
