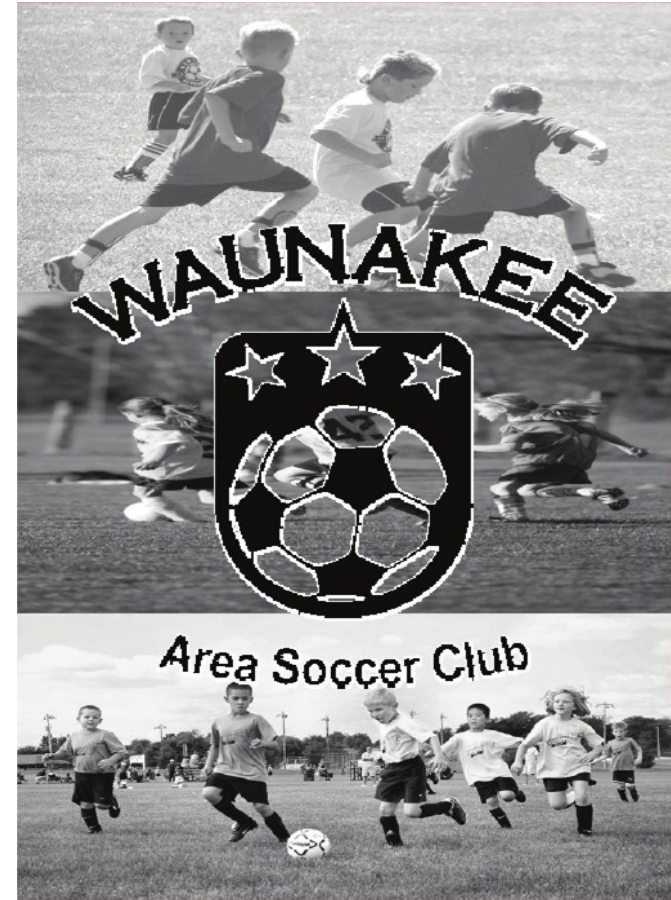

The Waunakee Area Soccer Club (WASC) is committed to providing a broader soccer enrichment experience for all children from Pre-School through third grade (ages 4-9). The Youth Soccer Developmental Academy is designed to provide the skills and experiences necessary to help transform your child into a skilled and confident soccer player.

The only prerequisite for participation is the child's desire and ability to make the time commitment necessary. As always, the Developmental Academy is a supplement to the regular team format and does not require your child to leave his or her current team.

The Academy experience provides additional opportunities for those children seeking more from their soccer experience. The goal of the program is to develop a deep-rooted love for the game as well as teaching the fundamentals of dribbling, trapping, passing and shooting. Emphasis is placed on participation and learning in a fun, yet challenging environment. The Academy builds upon earlier sessions and is designed to benefit both returning Academy players as well as new players.

The Academy program again features a 6-week session that has been designed to complement the regular season schedule. Each weekly session will allow your child to learn and build upon the instruction at a fun and comfortable pace. Your child will receive individual instruction focused on fun, skill development and soccer fundamentals. The 6-week program includes a t-shirt for all participants.

All Academy sessions are under the supervision of Coaching Director Jesus Torres and coach Mark Anderson, along with other guest coaches. Each Academy coach brings a wide variety of coaching insight and knowledge to your child's experience.
