However, some people should check with their doctor before becoming much more physically active. If you are planning to become much more physically active than you are now, start by answering the eight questions in the box below. If you are between the ages of 15 and 69, the PAR-Q will tell you if you should check with your doctor before you start. If you are over 69 years of age, and you are used to being very active, check with your doctor.
