- Thursday evening rate is \$151.00 single occupancy, \$206.00 double occupancy (per couple), which includes the Grand Lodge Banquet Thursday evening; continental breakfast Friday morning, and Deli Style luncheon on Friday noon.
- Friday evening rate is \$96.00 per room (single or double occupancy). **Does not include breakfast on Saturday morning.**

All of the above rates include tax and gratuities.
