### We Prepare For...

**Next Sunday:** First Sunday of Advent - December 2nd

**Readings:** Jer 33:14-16 1 Thessalonians 3:12—4:2 Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

Theme: Christ, the Center of Advent Hope

The messianic hope of Israel, launched with Nathan's oracle to David (2 Sam 7:11-16) is repeatedly echoed in the prophets. Today's reading from Jeremiah is a clear illustration. Christian belief centers on Christ as the realization of Israel's hope, as it sees the return of Christ at history's end as part of that same faith. Today's gospel, taken from Luke, which will be heard throughout this liturgical year, speaks of this second coming of Christ. Paul's letter to the Thessalonians, the first of his writings, composed in expectation of Christ's proximate return, sees a life rooted in authentic Christian conduct as the best preparation for that eschatological moment.

(Reflecting on next Sunday's readings before you come to Mass can bring so much more meaning to your experience of liturgy. How do the Scriptures touch your life?)
