Masterclass Program

John Monteleone, one of the best archtop and mandolin luthiers in the world will be at Cremona Mondomusica for a two-day masterclass/seminar. Monteleone, who this year celebrates 40 years of activity, will lead everyone in a journey through his career, with the presentation of numerous photos of his past and present workshops, and the discussion of his conceptual and philosophical theories for the construction of his instruments.

As we talk about the past golden age for archtop guitars, the topics will be:

Where are they coming from? How did they get this far? What has changed over the years in archtop guitar making? And what is the future of this type of guitar?

Making instruments with a great tonal quality is one of the main aims for Monteleone in his work. How to plan, design and build an acoustic archtop guitar, its foundations and principles of design are all important considerations for having tonal excellence. Selection, evaluation, and rejection of the timber for any particular project are key elements of the work process that will be discussed.

The instruments made by the unique Monteleone design are the essence of his artistic expression, able to reflect a subtle and brave union between form and function.

During the seminar they will be presented examples of design influences and how these have inspired him in the construction of his original and beautiful instruments.

To develop a complete understanding in the construction of string instruments with a keyboard, it is ideal a practical experience in restoration and repair. It may not be possible for the apprentice luthier having access to vintage instruments, but practice is the best way to improve the luthier's experience.

Among the many important topics for discussion, Monteleone will speak of the many interesting restoration projects coming from his work experience:

- The rescue and the restoration in 1978 of the #1002 guitar, the second guitar made by John D'Angelico in 1932, now on display in the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
- The restoration in 2010 for the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York of the #101 mandolin, the first mandolin made by James D'Acquisto and exhibited in the 2011 exhibition GUITAR HEROES.
- The repairs in tonal re-voicing in 1983 on the #75690 mandolin, a 1924 mandolin Gibson F-5 Lloyd Loar.

- The restorations in 1982 of Selmer #813, which belonged to Django Reinhardt and donated to Les Paul.
- The repair of the broken neck on the 1958 D'Angelico New Yorker #2049 and repairs to the tone bar on another guitar, both belonged to George Benson.
