First Grade Magnus Lector

Book Report

First Grade students should write a book report with 3 parts: the beginning, middle, and end. One page is designated for each part of the story. Page one will be an illustration showing the main character and setting. The bottom portion should be 2 or more complete sentences telling who/what the main character is and what happened in the beginning of the story. The second page shows an illustration of the story unfolding in the plot/conflict. The bottom portion should be 2 or more complete sentences telling what happens in the middle of the story. The last page should be about the solution/ending of the story, illustrated with captions. <u>All sentences must be very neatly written by the student and spaced</u> <u>correctly, with appropriate end marks.</u>

*In the oral report, the student will share the book's title, author, illustrator, main characters, plot and the student's favorite part of the story. First graders should be able to stand with confidence to present the report to his/her class and answer 2-3 quesitons from classmates about the book.
