

## CITGO First in Family Scholarship – 2014

**DEADLINE: April 4, 2014** 

**Scholarship Eligibility** – Applicant must be a graduating CCISD high school senior who will enroll in college in the fall immediately following graduation, and who is the first in his/her immediate family (including parents) to earn a high school diploma. Selected recipients will each be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship to assist with tuition and fees, paid directly to an accredited United States college, university or trade school of choice in Fall 2014. Scholarship recipient must enroll in a minimum of 12 semester hours to be eligible for this scholarship.
