Please insure that literature selections are appropriate for age, event, and presentation to a community audience. Literature selections must be published works that are available to all students. Selections that are found only in distributions such as organizational newsletters, the internet, and regional newspapers are not acceptable because they are not available to all grade 4-8 students. Appropriateness of both literature and mode of delivery is the responsibility of the principal. The principal should be aware of and approve all selections.

The top four BCSD winners from each category will be eligible to participate in the Kern County Oral Language Festival on Saturday, February 23, 2008 at Standard Middle School.
