Rob and Andy Bunch presented to Council premium illustrations from Companion Life Partners Plus. The City and Aurelia Municipal Electric's current plan has been dropped and a new proposed plan has a 12.76% increase. Wellmark Blue Cross Blue Shield displayed three other options for the City and Electric to review. After further discussion, the Council will set up a joint meeting to discuss renewal of medical insurance.

Long Lines Cell phones were discussed. Suhr, Howey, and Peterson currently have U.S. Cellular. The Municipal Electric voted to go with Verizon. After further discussion, Bowen requested a couple of Council members try the Long Lines Cell phones, and to table until next month's regular meeting.

Two sealed bids were opened for the 1997 Crown Victoria; Vance Greg - \$838.00 and Loren Godfrey - \$636.00. Henkel made motion to accept the bid from Vance Gregg in the amount of \$838.00 for the 1997 Crown Victoria, second by Lindgren. Roll call vote "aye" Keith, Lindgren, Henkel "nay" none. Motion carried. Ballantyne & Evans absent. Council advised Messerole to re-advertise the 1977 Ford F700 cab and chassis truck with 48,642 miles showing and the 10' dump box with hoist. Bids will be accepted until 7:00 pm, Monday, December 18, 2006. These two items will be sold separately. The City of Aurelia retains the right to refuse any and all bids. Keith made motion to approve the Municipal Electric Budget, second by Henkel. Roll call vote "aye" Lindgren, Henkel, Keith "nay" none. Motion carried. Ballantyne & Evans absent.

Discussion was held concerning removing old paint and repainting Pool Bathhouse floor. Mayor felt this was a minimal job and he will sand blast in the spring. The City employee's will paint the floor with epoxy paint.

Lindgren made motion to approve the renewal of Liquor License for Aurelia Golf Club and Village Boutique. Roll call vote "aye" Henkel, Keith, Lindgren "nay" none. Motion carried. Ballantyne & Evans absent.

Council discussed using the B.V. County Cat Rescue League. Council will use her on a case by case basis and will only be responsible for charges when the City contacts her.

The bill from Modern Heating & Cooling in the amount of \$4,513.50 for the new furnace for back of Library and Heritage Society was discussed. After further discussion, the Council will pay bill from Local Option Sales Tax.

City of Aurelia's current "Dangerous and Vicious Animals" Code, Chapter 57, was reviewed. It was discussed whether to prohibit Pit Bulls from coming into the City of Aurelia. Council will discuss further at their next regular meeting.

Community Center update was given by Bowen. Council reviewed a preliminary plan for a 95' X 80' new building, costing around \$570,000. Preliminary Plan is for an 18' X 28' room for the Legion and Auxiliary, banquet room twice the size of the current one, meeting room that seats 48, kitchen 16' X 24', handicap accessible bathrooms, mechanical room, large storage room, and bar. The Aurelia Municipal Electric did at their regular meeting verbally commit \$250,000 toward the completion of new Community Center. Anna Waddell brought up the issue of the newspaper office, Messerole will check into. Henkel made motion the committee proceed with the preliminary planning of a new Community Center, second by Keith. Roll call vote "aye" Keith, Lindgren, Henkel "nay" none. Motion carried. Ballantyne & Evans absent.

Overtime pay on Holidays for part-time employees was discussed. Council advised that Peterson is to use the Municipal Electric Employees for snow removal.

Bowen discussed with Council a storage container in a business district.

Bowen informed Council that the new dump truck will be in this week. It was discussed putting in a bed liner in the new truck and the blue dump truck, cost would be \$500 each. Council will not do at this time.

There being no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned
