#### **BLOOD & X-RAY RESULTS**

Please also note that all samples e.g. nail cuttings, urine etc need to be bought in before 2.00pm in order for them to be sent to pathology. Urine samples bought in after 2.00pm will not be accepted and new sample will have to be provided.

Alternatively you can send in your comments by writing in, we have a comments and suggestions box at the front of the reception desk which you may wish to use to leave your comments.


#### NORMAL MEDICAL CENTRE OPENING HOURS
