### **2013 SNOW PLOWING**

If you are interested in having your parking spot plowed out this winter, please let the office know ASAP for marking area.

The fee will remain at \$30.00 for the whole winter.

This means that each time the road is plowed, your spot will be cleared too. If you would rather have it cleared on an "on call" basis, you will need to pay a one time fee of \$20.00 for each request. Please give a 24 hour notice.

Payment will be due at time of service.

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As done in the past, if you are planning to join us for the Annual Bonfire, a discounted fee of \$10.00 will be charged to clear spot.

From The Desk
of the
Park Manager

As the season comes to a close, its time to announce the closing schedule for 2012. As always during the winter, all roads will be plowed out. If there are any emergencies, do to storms or heavy snow accumulation, notifications will be done as a mass email and placed on the website. Please, Tell friends and family that do not have email or internet. It is very important to have your contact information updated with new emails and phone numbers so all notifications can be forwarded to you.

Any Lot owners that want their <u>driveway</u> <u>plowed out</u> must notify the park manager or the office, so you can be put on the list. The fee for this service is \$30.00 for the winter or

20.00 per call in. This fee is payable to Cedar Shores before Dec. 31st, 2012.

When you have closed up for the season it is very important to notify the park manager or the office. This will help with providing security and assist in our list of final pump outs.

### **Closing Schedule**

Sept 8<sup>th</sup> - all boats can now be placed on the Ball field for winter storage.

October 14th - all services stop for the winter season, such as Leaf pickup and trash pickup. **After this date, do not put leaf piles in the road**. Piles will freeze and cause damage to the truck and plow.

October 15<sup>th</sup> - the dumpsters will be located at the pole barn. <u>Please only dispose household trash in cans</u>. All appliances, furniture, etc. is your responsibility to remove from the campground. Please break down your boxes before dropping them in the dumpster. This will help compact the trash and save money on dumps.

October 15th - Final pump outs.

October 16<sup>th</sup> - A.M. Water will be turned off to the park. The grey bathhouse will be open for the winter.

For Lot owners that snowmobile or cross country ski, I try to keep a few inches of snow on the roads. When snowmobiling, stay on the roads. **Do not ride on common ground or cut across lots**. There are spigots, wires, cable lines and meter boxes that you may not see. Avoid damage or injury by staying on the roads.

I like to wish everyone a safe and healthy winter and hope to see everyone back next season.

### Well, down to getting the end of the year business dates to you.....

October 21-27 - will be the last and *final reading* of all meters for the 2012 season.

Nov. 3rd - 17th - Wally and Cindy's *VACATION* Nov. 18- 24th - *Invoicing* for final meter reads and invoicing 2013 Association Dues and storage rentals, etc. Folding, stuffing, addressing, and stamping for mailing.

Nov. 26th - All statements in mail

Dec. 31st - All payments for 2012 due into office to close out budget and books for the year.

Jan. 1st, 2013 - "2013 Association Fees Due"

Jan. 1st - Enter and Begin the *new 2013 budget* and *open books* for upcoming year.

#### In the statement envelope you will find-

1 - One statement with an itemized transaction list for the 2012 year. Along with the <u>any</u> remaining total of balance(s) owing for the 2012

season. Please mail any 2012 balance

payment as soon as you receive your statement in November. Need to have by Dec. 31st.

2 - a statement with 2013 invoices, which are due Jan. 1st.

3 - the annual contact form, please fill it out and return. Even if you think your information is current, send it in for me to verify. I find emails and phone contacts change often and are not given to me. These are important for mass email contacts and emergencies.

### Remember, Remember

When making payments for the 2012 and 2013 invoices. Do them on 2 different checks. Anything paying for 2012 can be on one check but when paying anything for 2013, put on another check. They are applied to 2 different budgets and go to 2 different bank accounts. This will make bookkeeping much easier and helps for audit purposes.

Please inform office of changes with "winter" and "summer" addresses. I need to know when to switch for mail going out of the office. Forwarding has caused delays in getting statements on time.
