Auditors and workers are welcome to work with their dogs during breaks and lunch. *Although videotaping of Moe's lectures is prohibited, videotaping of your team's runs is highly recommended.*

Foundation Handling: Saturday April 9th, 8 am to 12 noon

Whether your team is new to agility or you need to fix some problem areas, this is the foundation handling seminar that will have exercises for all levels of teams. This seminar will help with the skills needed for a solid foundation in agility. All work will be on the flat. No equipment other than foundation equipment will be used (cones, chairs, targets, etc).

This seminar is open to dogs/handlers of all skill levels.

Perfecting Positional Cues: Saturday April 9th, 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm

The focus of this seminar will be on perfecting the handler's proper placement of positional cues, thus communicating to your dog timely and effective information on course. Dogs must be able to run a full AKC Standard Course. Contact obstacles and weaves *might* be used, but their performance will not be addressed.

This seminar is open to dogs/handlers competing or working at the Novice through Excellent Levels.

Excellent Handling Seminar: Sunday April 10th, 8am to 5pm

Learn how to create efficient lines, cue turns, and improve the timing of such. Work on challenges such as obnoxious boxes, threadles, wild weave entries, etc. so that you will be prepared to handle anything the judges throw out on a course.

This seminar is open to dogs/handlers that are currently competing or working at the Excellent Level and/or have the skills for this level of training.
