Information / Application
Packet

The Flint Hill Fire Department (FHFD) appreciates your interest in becoming a volunteer firefighter with our department.

The FHFD is a combination department with full time paid, part time paid and volunteer firefighters. All our firefighters receive the same training and are held to the same standards no matter what their compensation status is.

Becoming a volunteer firefighter for the FHFD will require a significant amount of your time and effort but you will be rewarded with experiences you will never forget. Being a member of the fire service is an exciting and rewarding commitment to helping others while gaining skills and knowledge you would not otherwise have an opportunity to develop.

Firefighting requires strenuous physical exertion as well as acute cognitive abilities to recognize unsafe situations and avoid them. Many people are not well suited to participate in the inherently dangerous work a firefighter does. For this reason the screening process for potential members of our department is rigorous.

This information packet will provide a high level overview of the requirements and process to become a volunteer with FHFD. Potential members are strongly encouraged to review the department Operations Manual which is available on the department website (www.flinthillfire.org) for more details.

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Requirements

Regular Member Applicant

- Minimum 18 Years of Age
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Driver's License (SC or NC)
- Criminal Background Check acceptable to the department officers

Junior Member Applicant

- 16 or 17 Years of Age
- Valid Driver's License or Photo ID (SC or NC)
- Parent or Guardian Permission
- Current High School Student
- High School GPA of 2.0 or better

All Applicants

- Reside within Flint Hill Fire District or close proximity
- 10 Year Driving Record acceptable to the department officers
- Ability to successfully complete the department PAT

Application Process Overview

- A prospective member contacts the department indicating an interest in joining.
- The prospect receives this information packet.
- The prospect returns the application with required attachments.
- When openings become available the application will be reviewed by the department officers. Reviews generally occur on the first Tuesday of each month.
- If accepted by the officers the candidate for membership will attend 4 Tuesday evening meetings/drills.
- During this time the candidate will review the department policies and sign an acknowledgement they understand and agree to abide by the department policies.
- The candidate will be voted on for probationary membership by the current members of the department at the first business meeting after the 4 meeting requirement is met.
- If accepted the probationary member will be issued equipment and participate in mandatory training prior to responding to incidents.
- The probationary member responds to incidents and participates in meetings and training during a 6 month (minimum) probationary period. The probationary member is assigned a mentor to guide them through the probationary period.
- At the end of the probationary period the member is voted on for full membership.

Training Requirements

New members are required to complete some initial training prior to responding to emergency incidents. Most of it is required by various state and federal laws. This training totals a few hours and is very basic in nature.

New members who are not already certified firefighters are required to attend a significant amount of formal training prior to operating in the hazard zone on emergency scenes. FHFD requires a minimum of FF I certification and NIMS training to operate in a hazard zone. The training is broken down into several courses which are offered at various locations throughout the area. York County operates a training center in Rock Hill where many of the classes are taught.

A mentor will be assigned to help you in your journey toward becoming a full member. Among other things, the mentor will assist you with scheduling the required training.

Training is offered at no cost to the student as long as the student follows proper procedures and the requirements of the SCFA, York County and FHFD. Students are generally responsible for their own transportation to training classes.

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Member Responsibilities

As a public service organization professionalism and customer service are core values of the FHFD. Members are expected to conduct themselves in a proper manner at all times, whether on duty or not. Members must familiarize themselves with the policies contained in the FHFD Operations Manual and abide by them. Volunteer members who violate department policies are subject to disciplinary action as described in the operations manual.

Volunteer members are expected to put forth a reasonable effort in contributing to the department's mission and goals. Volunteer members are subject to a semiannual performance review to determine if their efforts are consistent with current department expectations.

All emergency responders in the department must complete annual training requirements. The specific training required depends on the member's level of certification that year. The training is delivered in house by department instructors.

Upon acceptance as a member an emergency responder must have a Hepatitis B vaccination or sign a refusal form.

Member Benefits

Volunteer members of the FHFD are covered by Workers Compensation insurance managed by York County. Members are covered during department sanctioned activities and while driving to/from those activities.

FHFD provides a supplemental AD & D insurance to its members. This insurance is secondary and covers the gap between a member's primary insurance and their employment income up to a maximum of \$400/week.

The South Carolina Firefighters Association has a comprehensive benefit program including Line of Duty Death benefits, insurance, discounts and more. See www.scfirefighters.org for more details.

Members are allowed personal use of certain department equipment and facilities as defined in the FHFD Operations Manual.

FHFD pays the monthly membership fees at the Fort Mill branch of Planet Fitness for department members.

Members are issued clothing (e.g., t shirts, work uniforms, dress uniforms, work boots, jackets, caps, etc.) at no cost to the member.

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Application Instructions

If you are interested in applying to become a volunteer firefighter with the FHFD follow the instruction below.

- 1) Complete the attached <u>Application For Volunteer Membership.</u>
- 2) Return the completed application to the Fire Chief along with the following:
 - a) 10 year driving record (obtained from DMV).
 - b) Copies of any firefighting certifications attained.
- 3) Wait to hear back from the Fire Chief.
 - a) Applications are typically reviewed on a monthly basis but due to a variety of factors you may not hear back from the Fire Chief within a month. Please be patient.
- 4) If notified by the Fire Chief you are a candidate for membership:
 - a) Begin to attend Tuesday evening meetings (they start at 7 PM).
 - b) Complete and return to the Fire Chief the <u>Volunteer Candidate Conduct Policy</u>

 <u>Agreement.</u> Your application will not be considered by the membership without this form on file.
 - c) Attend 4 Tuesday night meetings. Have the <u>Volunteer Candidate Meeting Requirement</u>
 <u>Verification</u> form signed for each meeting you attend. Submit the form to the Fire Chief when complete.
- 5) Attend the next business meeting on or after completing the 4 meeting requirement (1st Tuesday of each month except for November which is the 2nd Tuesday). The members will vote on your probationary membership at this time.
- 6) If you are accepted by the membership you will receive turnout gear and other items and begin to respond to incidents.
