REFUND POLICY

All refunds must be requested in writing. There is no refund on the USA card or Pool Usage Fee.

Termination within two weeks after first practice - 100% refund

Termination between two weeks and 30 days after first practice - 50% refund

No refund after 30 days.

The attached forms must be completed and dues paid prior to any swimmer getting in the water. Return attached forms and money to a coach or board member.

CASC CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to maintain the Casper Aquatic Swim Club's ("the Club") reputation as a friendly and disciplined organization and above all for the safety and well being of swimmers. Members must agree to abide by the rules of the Club, and in particular the rules contained in the following Code of Conduct.

General:

The Club will not tolerate bullying in any form.

Members should behave in a polite and orderly manner at any time they are representing the Club.

Every swimmer must:

- Promptly obey all instructions from the coaches, board members and officials.
- Never argue with an official. Resolve potential dispute through your coaches only.
- Behave in a safe and responsible manner. Do not use abusive language or act in an aggressive manner.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Be a good sport.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Behave in a responsible and orderly manner in the locker room and on the pool deck.
- Respect the property of other swimmers and of the Pool.
- Refrain from consumption, use, or purchase of alcohol, smoking or chewing tobacco or any other illegal drug or banned substance of any kind. Any team member found or suspected to be in the presence of others (regardless of team affiliation) partaking in any of the above activities will be subject to expulsion from CASC.
- Be at required practices, on time and ready to work unless otherwise excused by the coach prior to the practice.
- Adhere to all curfews established by the coaches.

The coaching staff holds the final word on any rules, regulations, or disciplinary action taken regarding the violation of the above Code.
