For 30 years this annual event has been bringing together families while providing critical funding to one of our state's most significant assets—the Dallas Symphony Orchestra. Throughout the years, proceeds from this event have enabled the Symphony to maintain its high standard of excellence for its Education and Community Outreach Programs.

We look forward to receiving your nominations for The 2017 Presentation Ball, which we promise will be exciting and memorable in the most traditional sense.
