He has worked at the Rochester Institute of Technology, Nazareth College, Monroe Community College and St. John Fisher College. He has developed and presented professional development programs at numerous IACLEA, NECUSA, ACPA, NASPA, and ACPA conferences on a variety of supervisory, emergency preparedness, leadership and patrol officer topics.

Lee served on the Board of Directors of the Northeast Colleges and Universities Security Association (NECUSA) for six years and became the association's first two-term President in 2003-2005. He received the IACLEA's President's Award in 2007 for his work in creating a comprehensive campus crime prevention website. Lee is also the IACLEA liaison with the National Crime Prevention Council and is the President of WSM Trainers and Consultants that was established in 1996. He helped develop the 3-day Campus Crime Prevention Officer training program and serves as the principle trainer for IACLEA and NCPC in presenting this program throughout the United States and internationally each year.
