

CLUBHOUSE RULES

It is the responsibility of every member and visitor to help the Club maintain these rules at all times

DRESS CODE Smart casual dress is permitted in all areas of the clubhouse including the dining room (tailored shirts may be worn outside the trousers).

Jackets with shirt and tie must be worn in the dining room at all Club Matches and Club Functions when specified on the appropriate function notice.

Smart casual dress excludes wet and soiled golf wear, jeans, trainers, sandals, (with or without socks), T-shirts, track suits, shell suits, collarless shirts, as well as zip-up and out-door type jackets. Shorts are not permitted in the lounge or dining room.

Socks must always be worn with shoes.

Members and visitors are required to change out of golf wear which has just been worn on the course before using the Lounge or Dining Room. Relaxation of these rules on specific occasions is at the discretion of the board.

FOOD requiring a knife and fork must be eaten in the dining room or the designated dining area adjacent to it. Only sandwiches may be eaten at all other tables in the main lounge areas.

NO MOBILE PHONES The use of mobile phones is not permitted in any area of the Clubhouse except beside the public phone kiosk (at the main entrance) and both locker rooms.
