On **Thursday, October 11th**, our class will be participating in an Outdoor Education trip called ***Hunters and Gatherers***. This will be a great compliment to the work our class has done in Social Studies with First Nations people in Canada.

We will leave the school shortly after 9:00am and travel to a site northwest of town, near Condie. There is a small charge of **\$4.50 per student** to cover the cost of transportation. We will return to the school in time for 3:30pm dismissal.



On this trip, we will explore some of the ways that First Nations people of the Plains provided for their communities. We will visit a real buffalo jump and try our hand at some traditional hunting methods like archery and atlatl. We will then identify edible and medicinal plants on a hike through the valley. Students will also be able to learn the skill of lashing when they make their own travois.
