CALL FOR ARTISTS

"Upcycled Dreams" is an exhibition of artwork made primarily from recycled and upcycled materials. Upcycled Dreams will give new purpose and life to objects that typically would never be used again. Items such as coffee cups, broken electronics, unused textiles and many more will be upcycled into works of art that will be displayed. - 3-D art must be able to hang or sit on a flat surface.
