Registration Procedures

If any dancer between the ages of 8–12 is interested in joining our competitive program in September 2016, we ask that parents notify the office by April 4th.

This will allow our instructors time to assess the child in class to see if they are ready to participate at a competitive level. We will let all dancers know if they are being accepted into the competitive program by the middle of June.

Registration for Competitive Students

Once again, **all** competitive students will be asked to register in June of 2016 for the 2016/17 Dance Season

This will allow us to monitor class sizes and allow current competitive students the first opportunity to register.

We will be open for competitive registration during the month of June every Tuesday & Wednesday from 2:00–8:00PM

All other students can register in August.

RECITAL WEEKEND 2016

Our 2016 Recitals will be held at Hants East Rural High on Saturday, May 28th & Sunday, May 29th

The Creative Movement & Recreational classes will be divided up between an **11:00AM performance** and a **4:00PM performance on Saturday, May 28th.**

The competitive classes will be divided up between a **1:00PM performance** and a **6:00PM performance on Sunday, May 29th.**

When arranging the schedule we try to take all circumstances into consideration and be as accommodating as possible, however, please be advised if your child(ren) dance in more than one class per week, they **may** be dancing in more than one recital.

Please keep in mind, all Creative Movement and Recreational classes will be practicing on the stage the week of the recital. **Schedule will follow closer to recital time.**

Recital Tickets

Tickets for each recital will be available to purchase by Monday, April 25th for \$8.00 each. Due to the number of dancers participating in each recital, there will be a limit to the number of tickets each family can purchase. We will post these limits within the next few weeks once our dancer numbers have been confirmed. If you would like more than the number of tickets allotted, please call our office and leave a message or send an e-mail with how many extra tickets you would like.

Tickets will be held for each dancer's family until Monday, May 16th. After that date all tickets will be let go to the people on our waiting list.

Tickets are non-refundable, please keep this in mind when purchasing your tickets. If you lose your tickets before the recital or forget your tickets on the day of the recital, unfortunately, you will not be able to enter the auditorium until everyone has been seated.

Student Drop-off & Pick-up Policy for the Recital

You may have to wait for a short time in-line to drop-off and pick-up your children. Please allow time for this in your schedule. Our top priority is always the safety of your children.

Class Volunteers, Dancers & Teachers ONLY will be allowed in the changing area. One parent or guardian ONLY will be asked to drop-off their child at the doors of the changing area. At that time the parent will sign our class drop-off list and your child will be taken to their assigned volunteers by our staff. When picking-up your child at the end of the recital, the same parent who dropped-off the child, is asked to come to the changing area doors and sign our pick-up list. At that time, our staff will bring your child to meet you.

We understand everyone is extremely busy, however, we ask you to keep in mind that all dancers (the dancers who dance at the beginning of the recital and the dancers who dance at the end of the recital) deserve the feeling of a thunderous applause.

Once a dancer is in our care during the recital, you will not be able to pick them up until after the recital is over. If you must leave early, you must make arrangements with us by sending an e-mail by May 16th so we can inform the volunteers assigned to your child's class. Our staff will have to make arrangements to take time away from other students during recital time to meet you.

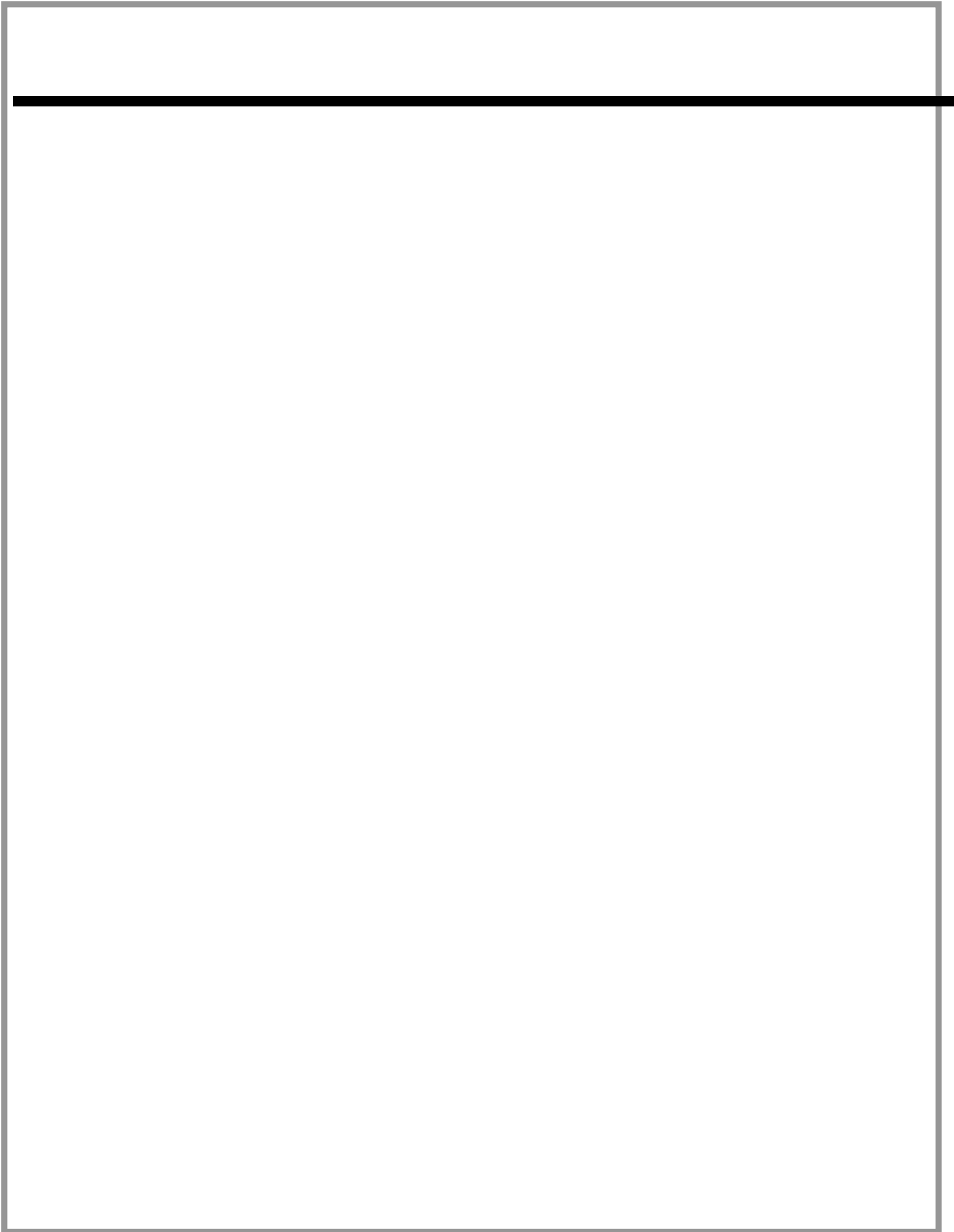
Dancer Drop-Off & Pick-Up
