On Saturday Jan. 21, our Prayer and Care Team will host a free class led by me, “How to Pray the Unity Way.”



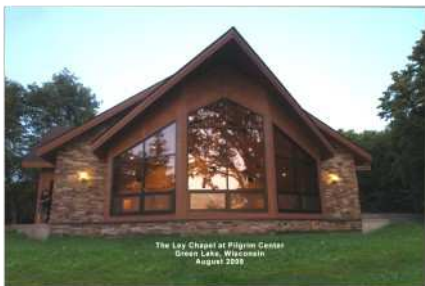

Follow Hwy. 26 for 11.6 miles to Rosendale.

Turn right onto W. Division St./WI-23 in Rosendale.

Follow Hwy. 23 for 3.6 miles to CR-KK.

Turn left onto CR-KK for 6.9 miles.

CR-KK becomes CR-K at County Line Road.

Continue following CR-K for 2.0 miles.

Turn right onto CR-A and follow it for .3 miles.

Take the first left turn onto Spring Green Road and follow it .3 miles to the Ley Chapel which is at W1010 Spring Green Road.

The GPS setting is N43 48.983 W88 55.898.

Travel time is about one hour.

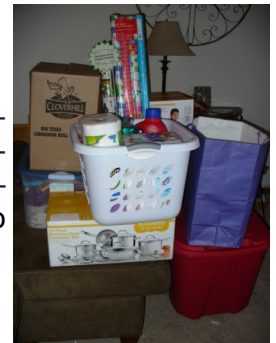
