PRAYER CORNER



There are those who may think that in having great faith, one does not need reason, believing that the two are incompatible. That is not necessarily true, for we know that reason accompanies everything that God does. Witness what happened when Moses, under God's guidance, changed the course of the Israelites during their exodus from Egypt. Pharaoh, totally misguided in his self-assurance as to the power of his charioteers in their pursuit of Moses, also had a short memory: God's raining down the many plagues upon Egypt. There was powerful reason behind God's purpose in this situation. By following the fleeing Israelites into the parted Red Sea, Pharaoh's men were neatly trapped as the waters closed in, drowning all in pursuit. Today, we may question what is going on in our lives. Our faith in God must admit that He has reason in all that He does. In that assumption, we, like Moses, are comforted and secure.

Loving God, we thank and praise You for Your faithfulness to us. As we watch the miracle of one season change to another, how can we not know that You are in control and aware of all that concerns us in our daily living? For the comfort of knowing that You hold us in the palm of Your hand, we humbly thank You. Amen.
