FOR JUST \$50 YOUR CAT CAN BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED, given a rabies vaccine, FVRCP (distemper) vaccine, flea treatment, and nail trim. If the pet is already vaccinated the surgery is \$30, but you MUST bring proof of vaccinations with you at drop off. Drop off times for surgery are between 8:30am & 10am. The cat MUST be in a carrier! Pick up times are between 6pm & 7:30pm. The night before surgery the cat should have no food after 6pm and no water after midnight. Please call 412-345-7300 x 211 to make an appointment!

**DOGS** must be properly vaccinated prior to scheduling a surgery (spay/neuter) appointment. Dogs who are not current on vaccines can be seen once in the ARL's Veterinary Clinic for a pre-surgical exam and vaccinations. Please call 412-345-7300 x223 to schedule an initial appointment. Cost Information: Dog Spay, \$135; Dog Neuter, \$115; Pit Bull (male or female), \$65. Please call 412-345-7300 x 211 for more information.
