PCAV SHOW JUMPING RULES TABLE 3.1 HEIGHTS & SPREADS

You may enter up to five rounds at any height, in total, including jump offs but only your best time & score will be counted for a placing all other scores will be super seeded as you can only be eligible for one placing per mount.

If rider completes 1st course clear and within the time allowed, they will stay in the ring to compete a pre determined jump off against the clock immediately, rider with a clear round and fastest time wins! The 'grade/riding specification' selected by a pony club member in an open section may be different to the grade(s) on the PCAV club member card, providing they declare by signing, that they are competent to do so.

- (Please download off the **Day attendance form** from the DPC website/ attached, fill out and lodge with the secretary on the morning of the event)
- Pony club members may ride in an open or a pony club section on the same mount except in horse trials
- Refer to PCAV Showjumping rules on the PCAV website current from Feb 1
- Classes are open to Pony club and open riders.

ALL RIDERS competing in the open section **must sign** a day attendance form and lodge this at the secretary's Office before riding and NON-PCAV riders must pay an additional, "day attendance fee" of \$10.00.

If rider completes course clear and within the time allowed, they will receive a participation ribbon,

A horse may compete up to five rounds at any height, in total

- The 'grade/riding specification' selected by a pony club member in an open section may be different to the grade(s) on the PCAV club member card, providing they declare by signing, that they are competent to do so.
- (Please download off the DPC website/attached, fill out and lodge with the secretary on the morning of the event)
- Pony club members may ride in an open or a pony club section on the same mount except in horse trials
- Refer to PCAV Showjumping rules on the PCAV website current from Feb 1
- Classes are open to Pony club and open riders.

ALL RIDERS competing in the open section **must sign** a day attendance form and lodge this at the secretary's Office before riding and NON-PCAV riders must pay an additional, "day attendance fee" of \$10.00.

Conditions of Entry

1. Novice : never having won a first prize at any Show or Gymkhana
2. No colts, stallions, rigs or donkeys. **No dogs permitted.**
3. Organisers reserve the right to make program changes
4. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into
5. No refunds on unused tickets
6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any person or to demand the immediate departure of anyone considered behaving in an unsuitable manner.
7. Riders and spectators shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to judges, show officials and their fellow competitors.
8. Pony Club Ring : Full pony club uniform must be worn at all times. One horse = one rider. Under no circumstances will a pony club rider be permitted to compete with more than one mount at any stage. Snaffle bits only.
9. **Pony club cards & Armbands must be inspected at the Secretary's Office before riding.**
10. PCAV approved riding helmets and footwear must be worn at all times when mounted.
11. First Aid on the day.
12. Gear check: Pony Club sections will run under owner onus system
13. Armbands are required to be worn by all competitors (Including non-PCAV members). No Armband, you will be disqualified from competing.
14. **No Lunging on grounds.**

15. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
16. Riders may only enter in one class per mount in ring 5.
17. Liability Disclaimer Neither the Doongala Pony Club Inc, nor the PCAV, nor any person acting on behalf of the organising committee, accepts any liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, accident, injury, illness to ponies, horses, riders, ground spectators or any other persons or property.

****** Should a horse or rider win Champion in one ring, they would then be ineligible to compete for the same event in other rings ******

Non –PCAV members need to present armbands prior to riding as well as submitting the day attendance form which shall be lodged at the Secretary's Office and pay an additional \$10.00 fee before riding.

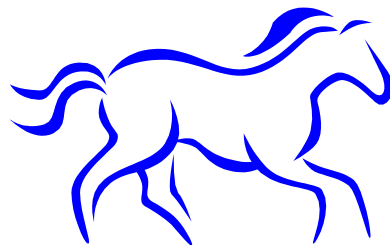
