## 9-1-1 Brings Help!

### WHAT IS 9-1-1?

9-1-1 is a 3-digit EMERGENCY number, which is easy to remember, that provides IMMEDIATE and DIRECT access to POLICE, FIRE, and MEDICAL SERVICES.

### WHEN TO USE 9-1-1?

Call 9-1-1 to report any situation that requires the IMMEDIATE response of a FIRE TRUCK, POLICE CAR, and/or AMBULANCE.

### DO NOT CALL 9-1-1 FOR:

- ®Road/Travel or severe weather information, repair of household appliances, or your car.
- ®Information about power outages.
- ®Complaints of excessive noise (TV), littering, pets up a tree, legal advice, or the time.

### 9-1-1 Brings Help!

**Dial 9-1-1 for immediate response of Police, Fire or Ambulance.**
