

WHAT IS 9-1-1?

9-1-1 is a 3-digit EMERGENCY number, which is easy to remember, that provides IMMEDIATE and DIRECT access to POLICE, FIRE, and MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEN TO USE 9-1-1?

Call 9-1-1 to report any situation that requires the IMMEDIATE response of a FIRE TRUCK, POLICE CAR, and/or AMBULANCE.

DO NOT CALL 9-1-1 FOR:

[®]Road/Travel or severe weather information, repair of household appliances, or your car. [®]Information about power outages.

[®]Complaints of excessive noise (TV), littering, pets up a tree, legal advice, or the time.
