Dear Family,

This week we have had lots more fun exploring our **Winter and Animal topic!** We enjoyed talking about the cold weather we are having, and exploring the frost and ice in our playground. We have also continued to learn more facts about polar animals and the Arctic and we explored Ocean animals. The children worked together in groups to make their own ocean creature models and we will continue them next week!

The children are very welcome to bring in Ocean creature books next week.

We are sending home an ICT sheet to find out about all the ICT your child uses at home. Please complete the sheet and send it back to school next week, thank you!

Maths:

In Maths this week we have been focusing on counting skills. We practised counting forward and backwards along a number line starting at different numbers. We also introduced counting in groups of 2 to 10 and to 20.

We introduced the children to counting in 2's initially by counting the 'pairs' around us: our hands/feet/shoes/eyes etc and then putting objects such as cubes, counting bears, links, beads, Lego, socks etc. in 'pairs' 'sets of 2' and counting aloud in 2's up to 10, 20 and beyond. We looked at numbers on the 100 square and practised saying the numbers in 2's and whispering the odd numbers until they got used to saying the numbers in 2's, e.g. from 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 etc. to '2, 4, 6, 8, 10 etc.' Please practise grouping objects in sets of 2 and home and counting aloud in 2's.

Please practise forming numbers from 0-10 at home, and beyond if your child is ready. In the garden this week we have continued to practise counting on to find a total, by playing lots of dice and number track games!

Literacy:

This week, we read a funny big book 'Hello, Big head' about a naughty pet parrot! In phonics, we have been practising the sounds we have learned so far, and have also learned the y, z, zz and qu sounds. We made yummy yoghurt on Monday to celebrate learning the y letter sound.

We revisit all letter sounds as part of our daily phonics session and we read phase 2 words and practise reading and writing sentences containing phase 2 words. We are encouraging the children to begin reading key words by sight when they are ready and to practise sounding out words both orally and 'in their heads'.

Please encourage your child to practise recognising the letter sounds and to blend the letter sounds to read the words in the table below:

Please remember that we read words, we "Look at the letters, make the sounds and blend the sounds together" to read the words

The children are doing very well at reading captions. Please encourage your child to practise reading these captions at home. We have also been practising reading captions in class. Thank you.


