Delivering keynote speeches will be:

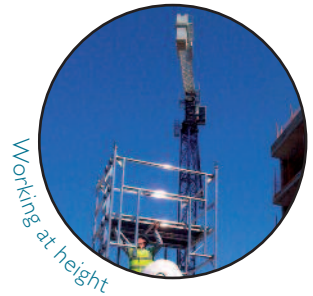
