Letter from the President – 2 October, 2015

Dear Member,

I am writing to <u>invite you to the 2015 NAPFA Annual General Meeting which will be held at Glendora Camping Ground Camping Area, Hill End, 7th of November 2015, 2 p.m. It would be great to have a big turnout – so combine it with a fossicking trip to Hill End or the Central West.</u>

This year has been a big year for NAPFA. Our major achievement, based on a good working relationship with the Minister for Resources and Energy, Anthony Roberts, will have been the creation of many new Fossicking Districts across NSW which I expect will be in place by the time of the AGM. This is an historical outcome for fossicking in NSW and will benefit fossickers into the foreseeable future. It is the sort of change that NAPFA set up to achieve.

Exploration Leases

The practical impact of this change is that fossickers will not require the permission of mining EL holders in those Fossicking Districts. It does NOT give fossickers any new rights of access — you will still require the permission of landowners or managers to fossick on non-Crown Land. You also cannot fossick on mining claims or areas where there is active mining. This change only refers to Exploration Leases.

However it will mean you won't be in violation of the regulations if you fossick on EL areas in any Fossicking District without permission of EL holders. It will remedy the current absurd situation where mining companies can deny fossickers the chance to fossick, or to warn them off, on land where they have ELs. In reaching this outcome NAPFA faced stiff opposition by the NSW Mineral's Council so in some ways it was a "David and Goliath" showdown. In this case David won!

Sluicing

We also put forward a detailed submission on highbanker/sluicing rules to the Minister and the Department and are continuing to work with them on that. We are seeking changes so it is clear to fossickers that the use of this type of equipment is permitted, provided the activity and disturbance limitations are adhered to.

National Parks

We are also continuing to work with officials from NSW National Parks about potential policy that could facilitate access by fossickers to some National Park areas. This is a complex problem and progress is very slow. But we will stay on it because in the long run it has significant access implications for fossickers in NSW.

Changes to NAPFA Constitution

The Committee recommends you support amendments to the Constitution to change the membership year and to streamline the new member application process. These 'special resolutions' will be voted on at the AGM. If you are unable to attend the AGM you may also give your vote to the meeting by ticking the boxes and returning it to our Postal Address or by email (scan) to Secretary@napfa.net. When we started NAPFA we used an 'off the shelf' model constitution. However now that we have been going for a few years there

are a number of practical improvements we can make to better administer NAPFA. More details are in the AGM section.

Membership renewals are now due

Your committee recently determined that NAPFA will do a membership renewal for the 2016 Calendar year. Renewal will cost \$25 per person. This makes us a very low cost association for members, within the reach of all.

Until now NAPFA has not required any members to renew – we have rolled memberships over since we started in December 2012. All current members also had the chance to win major raffle prizes, including a Minelab GPX 5000. This means that NAPFA has been excellent value for members.

In recognition of NAPFA's achievements, and to <u>help us maintain the numbers we need to be a credible</u> <u>lobby group</u>, the Committee urges you to renew your membership as soon as possible using the attached <u>form</u>.

You can also pay face-to-face at the AGM, the Goanna Gold Muster or at the Laanacoorie Bash which will be attended by NAPFA Committee members. <u>Bring your signed form and updated details</u>. Just look for our flag!

As a **BONUS**, any RENEWAL or NEW MEMBER before 15 January 2016 will also have a chance to win a Minelab SDC2300, to be drawn after 15 January 2016. Special resolution 3: Remove the requirement of nomination for new members, allow updates of the membership application Form, and streamline the membership process.

Your Committee recommends to remove the requirement for a written nomination to accompany a membership application, and removing the requirement for the membership application form to be in the Appendix to allow the committee to change the application form from time to time.

Your Committee recommends changing the membership process to allow easier administration and faster processing.

See below current wording in the NAPFA constitution:

Part 2 - Membership

2. Membership generally

- (1) A person is eligible to be a member of the association if:
- (a) the person is a natural person, and
- (b) the person has been nominated and approved for membership of the association in accordance with clause 3.

3. Nomination for membership

- (1) A nomination of a person for membership of the association:
- (a) must be made by a member of the association in writing in the form set out in Appendix 1 to this constitution, and
- (b) must be lodged with the secretary of the association.
- (2) As soon as practicable after receiving a nomination for membership, the secretary must refer the nomination to the committee which is to determine whether to approve or to reject the nomination.
- (3) As soon as practicable after the committee makes that determination, the secretary must:
- (a) notify the nominee, in writing, that the committee approved or rejected the nomination (whichever is applicable), and
- (b) if the committee approved the nomination, request the nominee to pay (within the period of 28 days after receipt by the nominee of the notification) the sum payable under this constitution by a member as entrance fee and annual subscription.
- (4) The secretary must, on payment by the nominee of the amounts referred to in subclause (3) (b) within the period referred to in that provision, enter or cause to be entered the nominee's name in the register of members and, on the name being so entered, the nominee becomes a member of the association.

3. Nomination for membership

- (1) A nomination of a person for membership of the association:

- (2) As soon as practicable after receiving a nomination for membership, the secretary must refer the nomination to the committee which is to determine whether to approve or to reject the nomination.
- (3) As soon as practicable after the committee makes that determination, the secretary must:
- (a) notify the nominee, in writing, that the committee approved or rejected the nomination (whichever is applicable), and
- (b) if the committee approved the nomination, issue a receipt for the amounts referred to in subclause (1) (b) and enter or cause to be entered the nominee's name in the register of members and, on the name being so entered, the nominee becomes a member of the association
