

- 4. Bring the decorated pie to school.




MATH

"MATH IS FUN"

At this primary stage, learning of mathematics lays the foundation for mathematical thinking in children. The children should be encouraged to do the calculations mentally as much as possible. They should also be asked to solve each exercise within a fixed frame of time. Math can be made enjoyable through games and activities and the same will enhance their thinking skills.

Give below are some suggested activities which parents can do with their ward at home.

- 1). Practice skip counting (by 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's)
- * Make a necklace using cardboards(square shape size- 2/2cm) for skip counting by 3's and 5's.
- * Roll nos. 1-21(skip counting by 3's)
- * Roll nos. 22-43 (skip counting by 5's)
- * Kindly follow the given pattern:



- 2). Identify the Indian coins and notes.
- 3). Play the following number line games:
 - a). Make a number line on a card board. (from 1-20, 20 to 40 and so on)
 - b). Make number cards from 1-100. Mix the number cards.
 - c). Let the child pick any card and place it on the number line.
