Dear Parents and Caregivers

Congratulations are extended to our children for their success in a number of activities during the last two weeks. The children acquitted themselves admirably during NAPLAN week. They came to school prepared and gave their best in all of the tests. We want to acknowledge and thank you for your efforts in supporting your children through this very important test week.

School Playgrounds

We are all about keeping our children safe and learning while they are at school. This includes parent pick-up times before and after school. Please keep your children with you and do not allow them on the play equipment during drop off and pick-up times.

Unsupervised children on our equipment can lead to accidents and we do not want to see any child hurt while they are at school. In addition, having their toddler siblings playing on the equipment is very distracting for our younger children while they are still in class. Similarly, having older siblings playing on equipment that is not designed to accommodate their size or playing on equipment they have not been supported to use safely can lead to the destruction of the play equipment or injuries.

Walk to School Day - 20 May

On Friday 20 May it is 'Walk Safely to School Day'. We would like to see as many children as possible walk, ride or 'scoot' to and from school. Of course, if your child is very young, an adult would need to support them on this day. Walking, riding or scooting to school increases the children's (and their parents') fitness and helps to alleviate the parking congestion around the school. Hopefully we will have great weather for the day, with lots of children and their parents forgoing their cars on this day.

School Uniform

We are very proud of the children at Beeliar for wearing their school uniforms. With winter just around the corner, most children have started to wear their school jumpers or jackets. However, we do have some children wearing non-uniform items. It is important that children wear the school uniform as it identifies them as Beeliar students. When the children are on the oval, they can be easily identified and this keeps them safe. Wearing the school uniform also provides children with the feeling of belonging and this is so important in our modern world. It would be very much appreciated if you would support the school to keep our children safe by ensuring they wear the complete school uniform.

IN TERM SWIMMING

We have had some enquiries into In Term Swimming. This will be taking place in Term 3 (weeks 3 and 4) this year.

We are informing you early that the payment will be no more than \$55.00 per student for the 10 days. Payment will be required by the 22 July 2016 (first week Term 3).

You can pay for your child/rens swimming via EFTpos at the front office closer to the time or if your child/ren have money in unallocated credit you may use this.

We have had some enquiries to paying off swimming lessons in instalments. This can be done by coming into the front office and paying cash or EFTpos and this will go into your child/rens account. When the time comes to pay for swimming through your child's yellow envelope, please let the office know that you have pre paid. Every child will still be required to fill in an enrolment form.
