The MTA Sculpture—The sculpture at Fenton MTA is by Flint artist, Bill Palmer. He is a blacksmith by trade and uses his skills for works of art and design. Palmer was commissioned by the Greater Flint Arts Council for MTA to create the sculpture. The United States Government, Art In Transit program provided the funding for the sculpture.

All MTA facilities have a theme for their art based on the many ways MTA enhances life for their customers. Fenton is known as a recreation area for Genesee County with all its natural habitat and lakes, the theme of recreation was adopted for the Fenton location in honor of how MTA provides the transportation necessary for many people to participate in recreational activities.

The steel cylinder made by Bill Palmer has cutouts depicting various sporting activities inlaid with copper features. As time passes, patinas will mature on the sculpture until the steel turns orange and the copper turns bright green.

City Council Chambers Tile Work—Of the "Old Fire Hall", Tile work by Carol Prior, 1981. The old Fire hall was torn down to build the Fenton Community Center and a new fire hall was constructed across the street.

The Fenton Gazebo was a project taken on by Tim Faricy and designed by Dick Kerzie. Plans were to complement the New City Hall Building with a band shell on the side. After completion, no money was left to complete the band shell. Tim took on the task to build a structure. The Gazebo was build with all redwood and volunteers from the community with \$15,000 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development and \$5,000 from the DibbleVille Questers. The project took 2 years and many weekend hours to complete. The city now maintains the structure. Many wedding and the "Concert in the Park" series are held each summer at the Gazebo.



Fenton Post Office

Post Office Mural—A famous artist Jerome Snyder designed the mural in the Post Office. The mural was painted in 1942 on the wall of the old post office on E. Caroline Street, as part of the WPA, supporting the arts all across the county. When the new post office was built great care was taken to move the mural to its location in the lobby of the Leroy Street Post Office.

Snyder was the first art director of Sports Illustrated and designed its well-known graphic format. He spent a decade as art director of Scientific America and illustrated a number of children's books. When the factory scene was unveiled a great deal of controversy occurred. In spite of the fact many people that lived in the village worked for General Motors. The community considered itself a farming community. As the years have past the mural has been accepted as a wonderful part of our artistic community.
