**TOP STORY**

Jan. 8 -- Texas Wesleyan races past Paul Quinn, 77-36  
DALLAS, Texas - The Texas Wesleyan women's basketball team registered 20 steals on its way to a 77-36 victory over Paul Quinn, Saturday evening in Red River Conference action.

Texas Wesleyan (8-6, 5-1 RRAC) put 15 points on the board before the hosts even registered a basket. Senior Shayla Coleman tallied six points, while junior Shawndrika Courtney added five points during the 15-0 run in the first four minutes of the contest.

Paul Quinn (0-14, 0-5 RRAC) cut the lead to 13-5, but that is as close as the Lady Tigers would get as Texas Wesleyan forced them into 11 first-half turnovers to take a commanding 45-15 lead at the break.

In the second half, Texas Wesleyan increased its lead to as many as 45, taking a 66-21 lead with 9:23 remaining in the game.

# COACHING STAFF



## STACY FRANCIS

Fourth Season  
TCU, '98

**S**tacy begins her fourth season as head coach of the Lady Ram

basketball team. A three-sport star at Austin's Sidney Lanier High School, Stacy was named first-team all-district in basketball, softball and track her sophomore through senior year. Francis shot 60 percent from the field during her three-year career. She was district champion in the long jump her senior season. Francis was also named to the district all-academic team for three straight years. She was named Who's Who Among American High School Students following her senior year.

After high school graduation, she accepted a basketball scholarship to TCU, where, following a red-shirt season, she started all four years. She started every game for the Lady Horned Frogs during her four-year tenure. Francis is fifth on the all-time rebounding list with 637 boards and seventh all-time in games played with 108. She is also 10th in career free-throws made with 178, and seventh in free-throws attempted with 290. Stacy received her Bachelor of Science degree in psychology in 1998. She also received her Masters in Education in December of 2004.

In her second season at Texas Wesleyan, Francis led the Lady Rams to an 11-19 record, which was an 7 1/2 game turnaround from her first year, when Texas Wesleyan finished 1-24. It is the second biggest turnaround in school history. The 2003-04 team featured three all-conference performers in Ashley Walker, Shayla Coleman and Shawndrika Courtney.

Last season, the Lady Rams again made a drastic improvement, by gaining 10 1/2 games on the season before, going 22-9. This was the biggest turnaround in school history. Texas Wesleyan again had three all-conference players. Ashley Walker was named first-team all-conference, while Shanwdrika Courtney and Kashae Townsend were both named second-team all-conference.

Since Francis' opening season in 2001-02, Texas Wesleyan has made an 18-game turnaround.

Prior to joining Wesleyan, Stacy taught social studies and coached volleyball, basketball and track at Fort Worth's Meadowbrook Middle School. She lives in east Fort Worth with her two cats, Blue and Chip.

She is the daughter of Barbara Price and Michael Gay. She has two brothers, Demarcus and Michael Jr., and one sister, LaShonda.

## ASHANTI NIX

TCU, '03

Ashanti begins her second season as assistant coach for the Lady Ram basketball team.

Coach Nix played high school basketball at Levelland High School. After high school, Nix played two seasons at Howard Junior College for Matt Corkery from 1998-00. Nix led the Lady Hawks to a 28-4 record her freshman season and a 24-8 record her sophomore season. She then went on to play two seasons at TCU, where she appeared in two NCAA Tournaments. Nix was third in steals and assists her junior year as she helped lead the Lady Horned Frogs to a 25-8 record and a WAC Tournament Championship. TCU made it all of the way to the second round of the tournament. Her senior season she led the team in assists and steals as they finished with a 24-7 record, falling in the second round of the NCAA tournament.

Nix graduated from TCU in December of 2003 with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology.

Nix has a five-year old daughter, Brooklyn and resides in Fort Worth.

# 2004-05 PREVIEW

## LADY RAMS READY TO TAKE NEXT STEP

A last-second shot in the conference semifinals ended Texas Wesleyan's season last year, but the Lady Rams are determined to take the next step and make their first-ever trip to the NAIA National Tournament. (Below is a Q&A with head coach Stacy Francis.)

**You return four starters from last year's squad. What do you look for in these players to contribute to the team?**

I look for my returnee's to bring experience and leadership to this year's team. Each player has something different to contribute. Shayla Coleman is a tremendous athlete who is very versatile on the court. She will play a vital role in our success this year. Her shooting ability will have an impact on what we are able to accomplish this year. Kashae Townsend will bring a strong and physical presence in the low post area. She is an outstanding rebounder who can take control of a game. She was ranked 13th in the nation in rebounding last season. LaRhonda Hunter will be the "spark" on the team. She knows how to get her teammates ready to play. She's a great motivator and is always looking to get her teammates involved. Shawndrika Courtney, a dominating post player, will be a tremendous force in the paint. She is dedicated to reaching her full potential and will bring the winning attitude that should spread across the team.

**What needs did you fill with this season's recruiting class?**

I believe with this year's recruiting class we will be able to handle pressure better and become a better defensive team. Tiffany Hill, a transfer from Hill Junior College, will bring more experience at the point guard position. She sees the floor well and knows how to make her teammates play better. She plays with a lot of finesse and desire. Britney Helton, who is also a transfer from Hill Junior College, will bring more offense to the team. Her shooting ability makes her a threat anywhere on the court. Lindsey Molinar, a freshman from Haltom City, will help us become a better defensive team. She has great footwork and will be able to disrupt the offensive flow of the opposing teams.

**Who or what will be the biggest surprise on this year's team?**

The biggest surprise on this year's team will be the fact that we have such a strong bench. Nastassia Brown and Lacie Curry will help with our inside play. They both are offensive threats and play great defense. Stephanie Reder, Kori Yates, Stephanie Sewell and Andrea Almond will bring solid play from the perimeter. Each player is capable of having a positive impact when they step out on the floor.

**Discuss the leadership role expected from your four seniors and its importance in relation to being successful.**

Leadership from my seniors will be very vital to our success this year. It is important that they know their roles on the team. Shayla Coleman will bring leadership by showing up to play every time she steps out onto the court. She's not a vocal leader, but she can definitely lead by her actions. Johnna Flemmons will bring a lot of hustle and is very vocal when on the floor. She puts her whole heart and soul into the game because no matter what she will give me 110%. Kashae Townsend is a fierce competitor who can change the complexity of a game. Her speed, agility and team attitude will help propel this program to new heights. LaRhonda Hunter will bring the desire to always play hard no matter what. I can count on her to keep

up the team's spirit.

**Comment on the strengths of this year's team.**

The strengths of this year's team will come from the defensive end. I believe we will have the capability to disrupt the opposing team's offense. I think we have several players that can be a force when defending. We should also be a very good rebounding team.

## TEAM NOTES

**EVERY YEAR IS GETTING BETTER:** Head Coach Stacy Francis led the Lady Rams to a 7 1/2-game improvement her second season at the helm in 2002-03. Last season Francis guided the team to a 10 1/2-game turnaround and the most wins (22) since the 1978-79 season.

**NEXT IN LINE:** Senior Shayla Coleman and junior Shawndrika Courtney are both capable of cracking the 1000-point club this season. Coleman is only 280 points away, while Courtney has 293 points to go.

**STINGY "D":** Texas Wesleyan held opponents to a .346 shooting percentage from the field. That percentage was good enough for third place in the nation. The Lady Rams also held the opposition to .246 shooting percentage from the three-point line, which placed them second in the nation in that category.

**STREAKS GALORE:** The Lady Rams used a seven-game and an 11-game winning streak on its way to a 22-9 record last season.

**CLEANING THE GLASS:** Senior Kashae Townsend led the Lady Rams last season with 8.8 rebounds a contest. That average placed her at 13th in the nation. The Hillsboro, Texas native registered 11 games with 10 or more rebounds.

**JUST IN TIME:** Former Lady Ram Ashley Walker missed the first five games of the season last year. The Bryan, Texas native led the team with nine double-doubles and scored in double-figures in 18 of her 26 games.

## SID W. RICHARDSON CENTER

The Sid W. Richardson Center was built in 1970 and has been the home of Rams basketball and volleyball ever since. The gymnasium holds 1,500 seats for both basketball and volleyball games.

The Sid W. Richardson Center has played host to NAIA regional championships, TAPPS regional high school championships, basketball camps, national and state table tennis championships, cheerleading camps and competitions, all-university picnics, multiple student activity programs and body building contests over the years. A true multipurpose facility, the center also hosts exercise and sports studies classes, intramurals and recreational activities.

The Sid W. Richardson Center is also home to the allied health center, which provides health services for students, student-athletes, faculty and staff and also contains an athletic training facility appropriate for CAAHEP accreditation of Wesleyan's athletic training education program. The program is under the direction of Dr. Pam Rast, Athletic Training Education Program Director. Kyle Morgan, M.A., L/ATC serves as head athletic trainer, while Erika Debro, ATC serves as associate athletic trainer and clinical instructor. Other athletic training faculty includes Kerri Horsley, L/ATC (assistant professor) and Debra Workman, L/ATC (adjunct instructor). The sports medicine team

is headed by James Bothwell, MD (team medical director and orthopedist), John Staniland (family practice), Marian Zinnante, MD (OB/GYN) and Bonnie Ahrens, PA (orthopedist). There are 12 student trainers who take part in the program and provide excellent coverage for

Wesleyan's eight intercollegiate sports.
